

The Anointing for Life

Overview: Our sins have been remitted by the precious Blood of Our Savior, Jesus Christ. As a result, our spirits are born again, free of sin and having eternal life. Nevertheless, every sin is an incremental step of the flesh towards the wages of sin, which includes physical death. This is true because to be carnally minded is death (Rom 8:6). But just as the actions of sin move our bodies incrementally closer to the death of the body, so likewise there are actions of righteousness which move our bodies incrementally closer towards eternal life of the body (i.e., towards a glorified body). Pro 11:19 As righteousness [tendeth] to life: so he that pursueth evil [pursueth it] to his own death. Rom 2:7 To them who by patient continuance in well doing seek for glory and honour and immortality, eternal life.

Pro 14:12 There is a way which seemeth right unto a man, but the end thereof [are] the ways of death. (Repeated in Pro 16:25)

A. The Sources of Life.

1. Father God.

Gen 2:7 And the LORD God formed man [of] the dust of the ground, and breathed into his nostrils the breath of life; and man became a living soul.

Deu 30:20 That thou mayest love the LORD thy God, [and] that thou mayest obey his voice, and that thou mayest cleave unto him: for he [is] thy life, and the length of thy days:

Psa 36:9 For with thee [is] the fountain of life: in thy light shall we see light.

Rev 21:6 And he said unto me, It is done. I am Alpha and Omega, the beginning and the end. I will give unto him that is athirst of the **fountain of the water of life** freely.

2. Jesus.

Joh 3:15 That whosoever believeth in him should not perish, but have eternal life.

Joh 3:16 For God so loved the world, that he gave his only begotten Son, that whosoever believeth in him should not perish, but have everlasting life.

1Jo 5:11 And this is the record, that God hath given to us eternal life, and this life is in his Son. Joh 5:26 As the Father hath life in himself; so hath he given to the Son to have life in himself; Joh 4:14 But whosoever drinketh of the water that I shall give him shall never thirst; but the water that I shall give him shall be in him a **well of water springing up into everlasting life.** Joh 10:10 The thief cometh not, but for to steal, and to kill, and to destroy: I am come that they might have life, and that they might have [it] more abundantly.

Joh 14:6 Jesus saith unto him, I am the way, the truth, and the life:

Joh 11:25 Jesus said unto her, I am the resurrection, and the life:

3. Holy Spirit

Rom 8:1 [There is] therefore now no condemnation to them which are in Christ Jesus, who walk not after the flesh, but after the Spirit.

Rom 8:2 For the law of the Spirit of life in Christ Jesus hath made me free from the law of sin and death.

Rom 8:10 And if Christ [be] in you, the body [is] dead because of sin; but the Spirit [is] life because of righteousness.

Rom 8:11 But if the Spirit of him that raised up Jesus from the dead dwell in you, he that raised up Christ from the dead shall also quicken your mortal bodies by his Spirit that dwelleth in you.

Act 20:9 And there sat in a window a certain young man named Eutychus, being fallen into a deep sleep: and as Paul was long preaching, he sunk down with sleep, and fell down from the third loft, and was taken up dead.

Act 20:10 And Paul went down, and fell on him, and embracing [him] said, Trouble not yourselves; for his life is in him.



- B. Your spoken word releases the Anointing for Life.
 - 1. Your tongue can release life.

Psa 103:5 Who satisfies thy mouth with good [things; so] thy youth is renewed like the eagle's. Pro 13:3 He that keepeth his mouth keepeth his life: [but] he that openeth wide his lips shall have destruction.

Pro 10:11 The mouth of a righteous [man is] a well of life:

Pro 11:30 The fruit of the righteous [is] a tree of life; and he that winneth souls [is] wise.

Pro 13:14 The law of the wise [is] a fountain of life, to depart from the snares of death.

Pro 14:27 The fear of the LORD [is] a fountain of life, to depart from the snares of death.

Pro 15:4 A wholesome tongue [is] a tree of life:

Pro 18:21 Death and life [are] in the power of the tongue.

2. The Holy Spirit confirms the life (i.e., Word) which you speak.

Luk 5:17 And it came to pass on a certain day, as he was teaching, that there were Pharisees and doctors of the law sitting by, which were come out of every town of Galilee, and Judaea, and Jerusalem: and the <u>power of the Lord was [present] to heal them</u>.

Mar 16:20 And they went forth, and preached every where, the Lord working with [them], and <u>confirming the word</u> with signs following. Amen.

3. Angels take action based on your words.

Psa 103:20 Bless the LORD, ye his angels, that excel in strength, that do his

commandments, hearkening unto the voice of his word.

Tit 3:8 [This is] a faithful saying, and these things I will that thou affirm constantly, that they which have believed in God

Heb 1:14 Are they not all ministering spirits, sent forth to minister for the heirs of salvation?

- C. Your actions release the Anointing for Life.
 - 1. Seek wisdom and understanding.

Eph 4:18 Having the understanding darkened, being alienated from the life of God through the ignorance that is in them, because of the blindness of their heart:

Pro 16:22 Understanding [is] a wellspring of life unto him that hath it:

Pro 3:18 *Wisdom* [is] a tree of life to them that lay hold upon her:

Pro 8:35 For whoso findeth (wisdom) findeth life, and shall obtain favour of the LORD.

Pro 10:17 He [is in] the way of life that keeps instruction: but he that refuses reproof errs.

Pro 12:28 In the way of righteousness [is] life; and [in] the pathway [thereof there is] no death.

Pro 4:22 The Word of God [is life unto those that find them, and health to all their flesh.

2. Live in the Fear of the Lord.

Pro 19:23 The fear of the LORD [tendeth] to life: and [he that hath it] shall abide satisfied; he shall not be visited with evil.

Pro 22:4 By humility [and] the fear of the LORD [are] riches, and honour, and life.

Pro 14:27 The fear of the Lord[is] a fountain of life, to depart from the snares of death.

3. Believe and live the Truth.

Rev 22:14 Blessed [are] they that do his commandments, that they may have right to the **tree** of life, and may enter in through the gates into the city.

Joh 5:24 Verily, I say unto you, He that heareth my word, and believeth on him that sent me, hath everlasting life, and shall not come into condemnation; but is passed from death unto life. Joh 6:47 Verily, verily, I say unto you, He that believeth on me hath everlasting life.

Joh 12:25 He that loveth his life shall lose it; and he that hateth his life in this world shall keep it unto life eternal.

Rom 8:6 For to be carnally minded [is] death; but to be spiritually minded [is] life and peace. Gal 6:8 For he that soweth to his flesh shall of the flesh reap corruption; but he that soweth to the Spirit shall of the Spirit reap life everlasting.
