Part 2 The Life of God
Module B

The Word of God

Overview

1. God is life; and death is separation from God. Jesus is life (Jn 14:6) and so death is separation from Jesus. Except for believers, the whole world lies in darkness (Isa 60:2, 1Jn 5:19) and spiritual death; and each unbeliever is expecting to die physically. Alas, they will die for, as one believes, so does one receive (Mark 5:36). Sadly, so will most believers for God's people perish for a lack of knowledge.
2. Jesus is the Word of God made flesh (Jn 1:14) and so He is the Word of Life (Phil 2:16, 1Jn 1:1). Speaking the Word of God activates over 40 spiritual laws (Refer to ABC Healing School) which are all designed to produce the manifestation of this Word of God which has been given voice (Ps 103:20). So, let us speak life to ourselves and to our loved ones.

A. Jesus is the Word.

1. The Word became the Son of Man, the Last Adam.
Joh 1:1 In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God.
Joh 1:2 The same was in the beginning with God.
Joh 1:3 All things were made by him; and without him was not any thing made that was made.
Joh 1:14 And **the Word was made flesh**, and dwelt among us, (and we beheld his glory, the glory as of the only begotten of the Father,) full of grace and truth.
2. All the blessings of Jesus are accessed through His Name.
Joh 20:31 But these are written, that ye might believe that Jesus is the Christ, the Son of God; and that believing ye might have **life through his name**.
Phi 2:9 Wherefore God also hath highly exalted him, and given him a name which is above every name:
Phi 2:10 That at the name of Jesus every knee should bow, of [things] in heaven, and [things] in earth, and [things] under the earth; v11 And [that] every tongue should confess that Jesus Christ [is] Lord, to the glory of God the Father.
Act 3:12 And when Peter saw [it], he answered unto the people, Ye men of Israel, why marvel ye at this? or why look ye so earnestly on us, as though by our own power or holiness we had made this man to walk?
Act 3:16 And **his name through faith in his name** hath made this man strong.
Note: All the power is in the Name of Jesus. Use it to speak life over yourself.

B. Jesus is life.

1. Jesus took death so you don't have to take it.
Rom 5:17 For if by one man's offence death reigned by one; much more they which receive abundance of grace and of the gift of righteousness shall reign in life by one, Jesus Christ.)
Rom 5:21 That as sin hath reigned unto death, even so **might grace reign through righteousness unto eternal life** by Jesus Christ our Lord.
Rom 6:3 Know ye not, that so many of us as were baptized into Jesus Christ were baptized into his death? Rom 6:4 Therefore we are buried with him by baptism into death: that like as Christ was raised up from the dead by the glory of the Father, even so we also should walk in newness of life.
Rom 6:23 For the wages of sin [is] death (*i.e., both spiritual and physical death*); but the gift of God [is] **eternal life** (*i.e., both spiritual and physical*) through Jesus Christ our Lord.
Rom 8:2 Law of the Spirit of life in Christ Jesus has made me free from the law of sin & death.

2Co 4:11 For we which live are always delivered unto death (*i.e., die to self, pride and sin*) for Jesus' sake, that the **life** also of Jesus might be made **manifest in our mortal flesh**.

2Ti 1:10 But is now made manifest by the appearing of our Saviour Jesus Christ, who hath **abolished death**, and hath brought **life and immortality to light** through the gospel:

Heb 2:9 We see Jesus, who was made a little lower than the angels for the suffering of death, crowned with glory and honour; that he by the grace of God should taste death for every man.

2. Jesus is Life; therefore life lives in you; so let His Life saturate you.

John 14:6 Jesus is the way, the truth and the **life**.

1Jo 5:12 He that hath the Son hath life; [and] he that hath not the Son of God hath not life.

Joh 11:25 Jesus said unto her, I am the resurrection, and the life: he that believeth in me, though he were dead, yet shall he live:

Joh 11:26 **And whosoever liveth and believeth in me shall never die**. Believest thou this?

Note: Jesus is a quickening spirit, a spirit who gives life. Receive this eternal life in your body by believing and speaking it.

C. The Word is Life.

1. The Word is in your heart.

Deu 30:14 The word [is] very nigh thee, in thy mouth, and in thy heart, that thou may do it.

Rom 10:8 But what saith it? The word is nigh thee, [even] in thy mouth, and in thy heart: that is, the word of faith, which we preach;

1Jo 5:11 And this is the record, that God hath given to us eternal life, and this life is in his Son.

Luke 6:45 for out of the abundance of the heart, the mouth speaks. *Speak life to your body*.

2. Receive the Word of Life by believing and speaking it.

Phi 2:15 That ye may be blameless and harmless, the sons of God,.... shine as lights in the world; v16 holding forth the **word of life**;

1Jo 1:1 That which was from the beginning, which we have heard, which we have seen with our eyes, which we have looked upon, and our hands have handled, of the **Word of life**..

Joh 6:63 It is the spirit that quickeneth (*i.e. understands and receives the life*); the flesh profits nothing (*i.e., does not understand*): the words that I speak unto you, [they] are spirit, and life.

Joh 5:24 Verily, I say unto you, He that heareth my word, and believeth on him that sent me, hath everlasting life, and shall not come into condemnation; but is passed from death unto life.

Note: You are not condemned, living on death row. Feed your spirit and body the Word of Life.

D. Manifesting Life in our lives.

1. Receive Communion and feed on the Word of God.

Rom 5:10 For if, when we were enemies, we were reconciled to God by the death of his Son, much more, being reconciled, we shall be saved (*i.e.,*

? completely, all five parts) by his life.

Joh 6:33 The bread of God is he which comes down from heaven, & gives life unto the world.

Joh 6:48 I am that bread of life. v49 Your fathers did eat manna in the wilderness, and are dead. v 50 This is the bread which comes down from heaven, that a man may eat and not die.

Prov 4:22 The Word of God is **life** to those that find them and health to all their flesh.

2. Speak the Word of Life.

Jud 1:21 Keep yourselves in the love of God, looking for the mercy of our Lord Jesus Christ unto eternal life.

Luk 5:17 And it came to pass on a certain day, as he was teaching, and the power of the Lord was [present] to heal them.

Mar 16:20 And they went forth, and preached every where, the Lord working with [them], and confirming the word with signs following.

Note: Preach to yourself, "In the Name of Jesus, I shall be alive & remain when Jesus returns."
