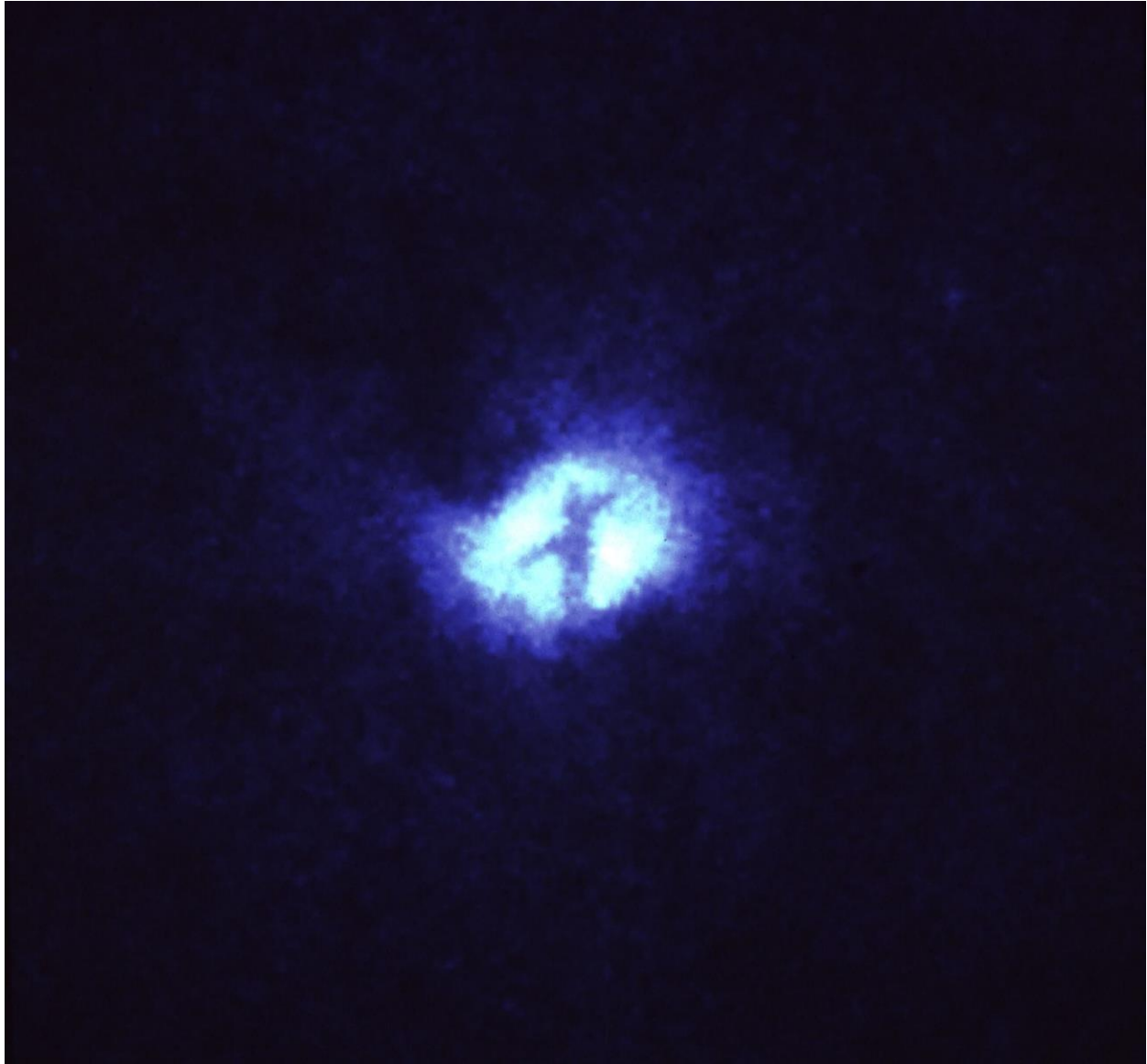


The Hubble Telescope Space Cross

A. Even the Heavens Declare the Glory of Our God.

1. The Hubble Telescope shows the Cross in outer space for all the universe to witness.

 - a. The heavens declare the glory of God; and the firmament shows His handiwork. Ps 19:1
 - b. For by Him all things were created that are in heaven and that are on earth, visible and invisible, whether thrones or dominions or principalities or powers. All things were created through Him and for Him. Col 1:16

B. Why Is The Death of Jesus Called Good Friday?

Col 1:13-14, Acts 20:28

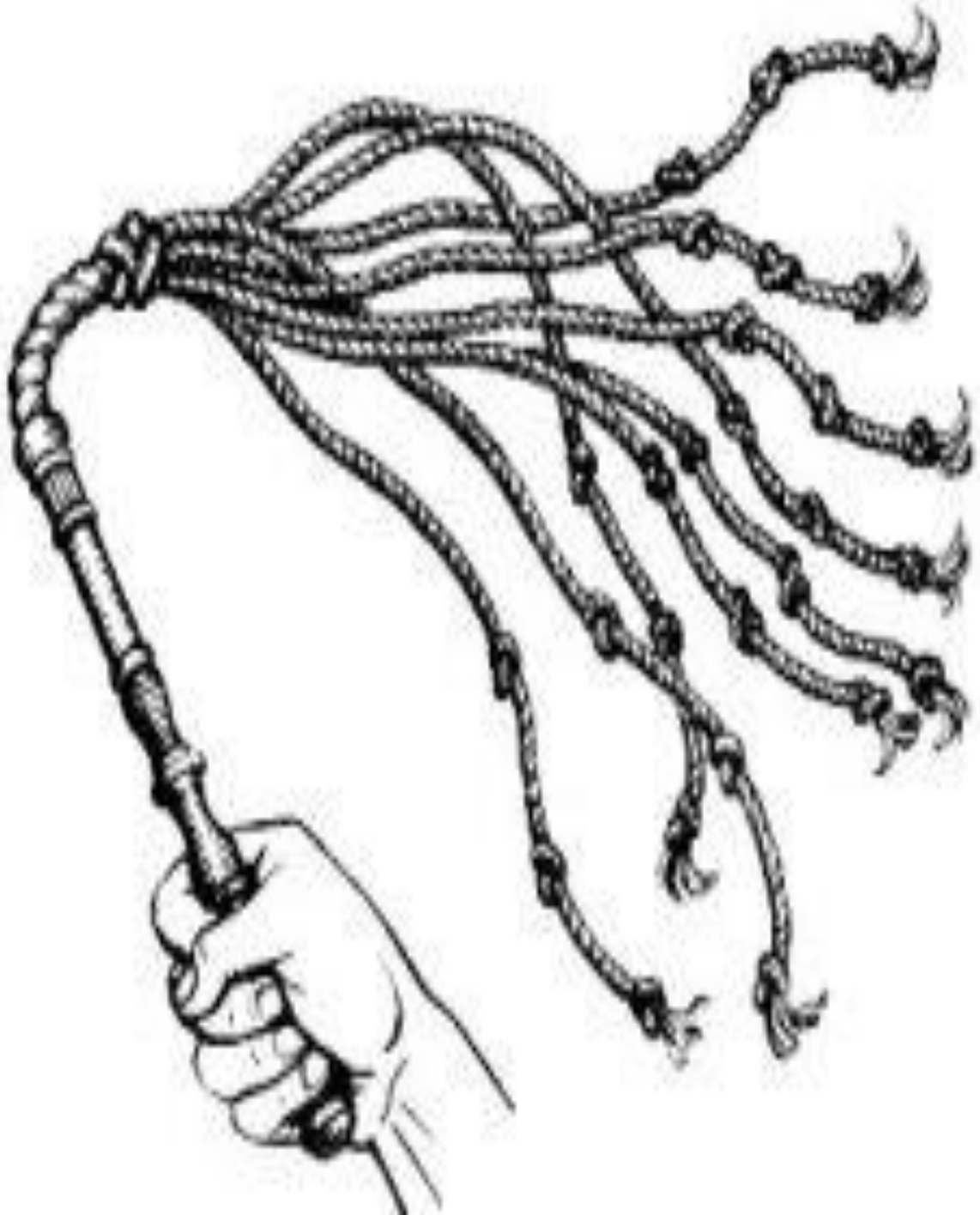
E. Over One Hundred Prophecies Foretold of How Redemption Would Happen.

F. It Is Finished!

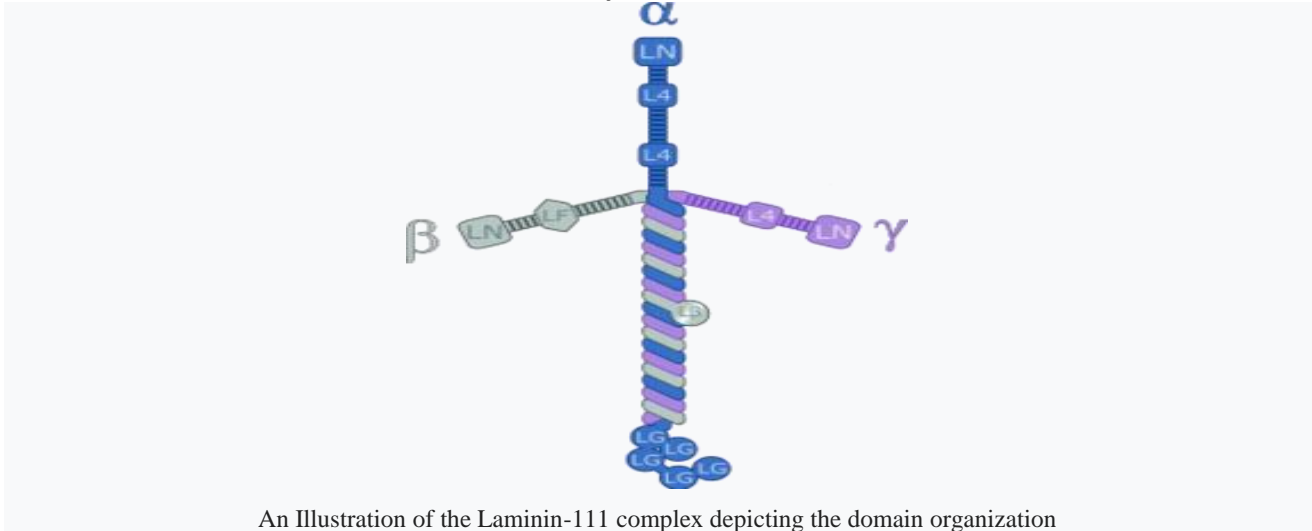
1. On the Cross, Jesus said, "Father, forgive them..." Luke 23:34
2. The last thing Jesus said before he died was, "It Is Finished!" ...and bowing His head, He gave up His spirit. Jn 19:28-30, Jn 17:4
 - a. Even our body is glued together with the "Laminin Cross" so that we could be made complete in Christ Jesus, a finished work. Col 2:10, Jn 1:3, Phil 1:6

Laminins are high-molecular weight proteins of the extracellular matrix. They are a major component of the basal lamina, **a protein network foundation for most cells and organs**. The laminins are an important and biologically active part of the basal lamina, **influencing cell differentiation, migration, and adhesion**.

The trimeric proteins intersect to form a cross-like structure that can bind to other cell membrane and extracellular matrix molecules.

The three shorter arms are particularly good at binding to other laminin molecules, which allows them to form sheets.

The long arm is capable of binding to cells, which helps anchor organized tissue cells to the membrane.

The laminin family of glycoproteins are an integral part of the structural scaffolding in almost every tissue of an organism. They are secreted and incorporated into cell-associated extracellular matrices.

Laminin is vital for the maintenance and survival of tissues.
