Fulness of the Heart

Overview: As a man thinks in his heart, so is he. So, the abundance of the heart on any topic will determine what a person speaks and therefore what s/he does on that topic. When the abundance of the heart is the Word of God, the person will in most things speak the Word and act on the Word. The goal is to have one's heart completely filled with the Word of God so that in every area what comes out of the mouth is the Word of God. This creates a loving, forgiving lifestyle and results in the person being filled with the fulness of God. This only comes about by saturation in God and His Word.

A. What is the Heart?

1. Man is a spirit. He has a soul and lives in a body.
1Th 5:23 And the very God of peace sanctify you wholly; and [I pray God] your whole spirit and soul and body be preserved blameless **unto the coming of our Lord Jesus Christ.**
2. Man is a five part being.
The gate/door between the spirit and the soul is the heart; between soul and body is the mind.
Mat 22:37 Jesus said unto him, Thou shalt love the Lord thy God with all thy heart, and with all thy soul, and with all thy mind.
3. Number of verse references in the entire Bible:
spirit 456 soul 432 heart **765** body 152 mind 92
4. The Heart is the veil that controls the flow of God's power in your life.
2Co 3:15 But even unto this day, when Moses is read, the vail is upon their heart.
5. The Heart is the gate or door that controls the flow of God's power in your life.
Psa 24:7 Lift up your heads, O ye gates; and be ye lift up, ye everlasting doors; and the King of glory shall come in. v8 Who [is] this King of glory? The LORD strong and mighty, the LORD mighty in battle. v9 **Lift up your heads, O ye gates; even lift [them] up, ye everlasting doors; and the King of glory shall come in.**
Psa 24:10 Who is this King of glory? **The LORD of hosts**, he [is] the King of glory. Selah.

B. Power of the Heart.

1. Eph 3:14-20 When Christ dwells fully in your heart you are filled with fulness of God.
2. Mark 11:23 You can move mountains with your words if you do not doubt in your heart.
3. Mat 12:34 O generation of vipers, how can ye, being evil, speak good things? for out of the abundance of the heart the mouth speaketh.
4. Jam 1:21 The engrafted Word (*i.e., Word in your heart*) saves your soul.
5. Mar 4:13 And he said unto them, Know ye not this parable? and how then will ye know all parables? Mar 4:14 The sower soweth the word.
Mar 4:15 And these are they by the way side, where the word is sown; but when they have heard, Satan cometh immediately, and taketh away the word that was sown in their hearts.
Mar 4:20 And these are they which are sown on good ground; such as hear the word, and receive [it], and bring forth fruit, some thirtyfold, some sixty, and some an hundred.
Luk 8:15 But that on the good ground are they, which **in an honest and good heart**, having heard the word, keep [it], and bring forth fruit with patience.

C. The Word and the Heart.

1. Luk 6:45 A good man out of the good treasure of his heart brings forth that which is good; and an evil man out of the evil treasure of his heart brings forth that which is evil: **for of the abundance of the heart his mouth speaks.**
Luk 6:46 And why call ye me, Lord, Lord, and do not the things which I say?
2. .Pro 18:21 Death and life [are] in the power of the tongue: they that love it shall eat the fruit.

3. Pro 4:23 **Keep thy heart with all diligence; for out of it [are] the issues of life.**
4. Repetition of hearing and speaking the Scriptures. You cannot hear a teaching too often.
Before you read the Word, confess your sins and ask the Holy Spirit for revelation of the Word.
Jos 1:8 This book of the law shall not depart out of thy mouth; but thou shalt meditate therein day and night, that thou mayest observe to do according to all that is written therein: for then thou shalt make thy way prosperous, and then thou shalt have good success.
Rom 10:17 So then faith [cometh] by hearing, and hearing by (*i.e. through*) the word of God.
Also: faith cometh by hearing and hearing; hearing comes (*i.e., is produced*) by the Word.
When your heart is filled with the abundance of God's Word in healing, the fire of your first love for Jesus will be reignited in the area of healing:
 You will never get tired of hearing healing being taught by anyone.
 You will burn with the desire to teach healing to others. You will prepare for it.
 You will speak and act on healing automatically and throughout the day.
5. Process
Cycle of Change: Hear the Word to transform your mind; act on it to put it into your heart; and speak it to teach/guide your soul. Refer: Structure of Man Diagram on Page 3.
Rom 12:2 And be not conformed to this world: but be ye transformed by the renewing of your mind, that ye may prove what [is] that good, and acceptable, and perfect, will of God.
Pro 21:23 Whoso keepeth his mouth and his tongue keepeth his soul from troubles.
Pro 6:2 Thou art snared with the words of thy mouth, thou art taken with the words of thy mouth.
More detail on the Cycle of Change: Hear, speak and do (*i.e., act*) to change the outer man; the speaking guides the soul through the conscience, which either becomes seared or affects the word in your heart, thus parting your heart and allowing the anointing to flow out; and then God's Word comes out of the abundance of the heart through the tongue to set the soul free.

D. The Fulness of the Heart is the Way.

1. When the abundance of the heart consists of the Word of God, there is an abundance of anointing, available to be released through your words. Since your tongue guides your life, as the abundance of the Word flows out through your tongue, the **anointing of God prepares the way** of your life. Deu 31:8 And the LORD, he [it is] that doth go before thee; he will be with thee, he will not fail thee, neither forsake thee: fear not, neither be dismayed.
2. **Jesus is the Way.** When your days and life are focused on Jesus, you become saturated with His Word and anointing. Then, as you speak, His words and His anointing leads you where you should go.
Hab 3:19 AMPC The Lord God is my Strength, my personal bravery, and my invincible army; He makes my feet like hinds' feet and will make me to walk [not to stand still in terror, but to walk] and make [spiritual] progress upon my high places [of trouble, suffering, or responsibility]! **The fulness of the heart is a good description of the engrafted Word.**
3. **Jesus is the Word.** When you place His Word in first place, you make Him first in your life. Becoming immersed in the Word, having your life and thoughts saturated with the Word, produces an intimacy where you hear and know the voice of the Good Shepherd.
4. **Jesus is love.** The abundance of His Word in your heart creates an abundance of love in your life. That is how you live as a loving, forgiving person, walking in great peace and patience.
Psa 119:165 Great peace have they which love thy law: and nothing shall offend them.
5. Ps 22:3 God inhabits the praises of His people. Fill your heart with an abundance of praise and worship. It will flow out, flooding you with His life and anointing as He dwells in your praise and as you worship Him in truth by speaking and living His Word.
