

ABC Cleansing Retreat Outlines Sunday Sept 16, 2018

Cleansing through Partnering with God

Overview: The process of becoming a Manifested Son of God is a synergistic partnership/relationship between you and your Father, your Abba Daddy. You are the initiator through the process while He empowers the change by the Word and by the Spirit. Keep taking daily steps toward Him.

A. Partnering with Your Heavenly Father

1. Christ is our Wisdom, Righteousness, Sanctification and Redemption. 1 Cor 1:30
2. Work out your own salvation with fear and trembling. Phil 2:12-13
2. Changed by Faith in the work of the Spirit of God. Gal 3:1-3
3. Changed from glory to glory as by the Spirit. 2 Cor 3:18

B. Process of Cleansing – 4 Verbs on Cleansing

1. Cleanse – *katharizo* - wash, cleanse, purify.
 - God – Cleanses with the Word. Eph 5:26; Tit 2:14
 - Us – Cleanse ourselves – called as Sons of God. 2 Cor 7:1; Jam 4:8
 - Process – Discover sins/curses and break them. 2 Tim 2:24-26
2. Sanctify – *hagiazō* - to make holy, set apart for a holy purpose, purify.
 - God – Sanctifies us with the Word. Eph 5:26; Jn 17:17; 1 Thes 5:23
 - Us – Sanctify the Lord God in your hearts. 1 Pet 3:15
 - Process – Word of God – Study, Speak, Do. (Obey) James 1:22-25
3. Purge – *ekkathairo* - To cleanse thoroughly.
 - God – Present to Himself a glorious church without spot. Eph 5:27
 - Us – Purge ourselves from these things. 2 Tim 2:21; 1 Cor 5:7
 - Process – Cast out demons, devils and evil spirits.
4. Purify – *hagnizo* - to make clean, purify, sanctify.
 - God – Jesus is our sanctifier. 1 Cor 1:30
 - Us – Purify ourselves even as He is pure. 1 John 3:3; Jam 4:8
 - Process – Obey Holy Spirit, disobey mind control spirits. James 4:7
5. Cleansing Process Summary
 - Compare self to the Word – identify sins 2 Tim 3:16-17
 - Power of God for sanctification. Eph 1:19, 3:16
 - Expect the power of God, with the Word to change you. Gal 3:1-3
 - Speak the Word to release the anointing Mark 16:20
 - Consecration of everything to God.
 - Diligent discipline – utilize the tools Matt 11:12
 - Cast out the demons, devils and evil spirits

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A. Living a Cleansed Life after the Retreat.

1. A holy lifestyle is crucial for preventing demons from re-entering your life.
 - a) Be on the alert for recurring temptations.
 - b) Treat all temptations as sins: confess, repent, forgive if appropriate, renounce and break; then cast out the demons/devils/evil spirits behind the temptations.
 - c) Confess every known sin immediately. Make it a habit to receive cleansing for all your **unknown** sins regularly by praying, "Lord, I am not aware of any known sins, so in the Name of Jesus, please cleanse me of all unrighteousness."
 - In the Name of Jesus, I bind up every demon/devil/evil spirit behind these sins.
 - In the Name of Jesus, I cast them out of me, my home and my life.
2. Cleanse your sphere of influence.
 - a) Home. 3 Witness your home. Establish the Blood Line around your home/property; Cleanse all new items brought into the house.
 - b) Habits. Go after the demons behind every bad habit.
 - c) Friends and acquaintances. Evaluate and prioritize their influence on you.
Pro 27:17 Irons sharpens iron.
Ps 42:7 Deep calls unto deep.
2 Cor 6:14 Be equally yoked.
 - d) Evaluate the Godly value of where you go and what you do.
3. Live in the Kingdom of God.
 - a) Establish the Kingdom of God around you and keep it established.
 - b) You are the bearer of the Glory of God. You are a God chaser. You have within you a Holy Guest, called the Holy Ghost.
 - c) Play praise and worship music, if possible, 24 hours per day.
4. Be a loving forgiving person.
 - a) Mt 18:35 Be quick to forgive from your heart. If you start to lose your joy, peace or patience, forgive those who were interacting with you.
 - b) When forgiving and blessing others, it is better to err by doing it too frequently.

B. Putting God first for the rest of your life.

1. Consecration.
 - a) Consecrating: your life, goals, relationships, possessions.
 - b) Flee sins.
 - c) What Would Jesus Do?
2. Strategic Affirmations.

Rom 6:11 In the Name of Jesus, I reckon myself dead to sin but alive unto God through Christ Jesus, my Lord.

1 Cor 2:16 In the Name of Jesus, I have the mind of Christ.

Ps 19:14 In the Name of Jesus, God has made the words of my mouth and the meditations of my heart pleasing to Him.
3. Steps to maintain a Consecrated Lifestyle.

This weekend began a process that is intended to lead to a more victorious life. It is the process of cleansing and of sanctification by the Word of God and the power of the Holy Spirit. **The spiritual foundation is a consecrated and committed lifestyle.** That lifestyle should reflect the following elements. Each of these elements helps to keep the demonic influences and hooks out of our lives:

- a) Start each day with the Morning Prayer. See Section B 4 a).
 - b) Confess your sins frequently: known sins as soon as possible, unknown sins once every 1 - 2 hours. See Section B 4 b).
 - c) Read/Study the Bible.
 - d) Attend Church at least twice per week.
 - e) Take communion at least once per day.
 - f) Be alert for offense and instantly forgive others.
 - g) Do Affirmations and pray in tongues.
 - h) Be a person of praise and worship.
 - i) Give tithes and offerings.
 - j) Fast on a regular basis.
4. Daily Foundational Prayers.
- a) Morning Prayer.
Heavenly Father, in the Name of Jesus, I am not aware of any sins since the last time I confessed; so, right now, I am asking You to cleanse me for all my unknown sins (1 John 1:9). In the Name of Jesus, I receive forgiveness for all my sins and I renounce all the devils and evil spirits behind these sins.

In the Name of Jesus, I ask the Holy Spirit to fall afresh on me.
In the Name of Jesus, I bind satan and all his devils and evil spirits this day from me and all that concerns me. In the Name of Jesus, this day I loose into my life, and into all that concerns me, the will of my Heavenly Father, the powers of Heaven and the angels of God. (Matt 18:18)
 - b) Confessing sins.
 - 1) **Whenever you sin**, use 1 John 1:9 as soon as possible to confess your sins as follows:
Heavenly Father, in the Name of Jesus, **I repent of the sin of _____**. In the Name of Jesus, I receive forgiveness for this sin and I renounce satan and every devil and evil spirit behind all of my sins. In the Name of Jesus, I invite the Holy Spirit to fall afresh on me and I loose the will of my Heavenly Father and His angels into my life and all that concerns me.
 - 2) **If you go 1 - 2 hours without any known sins**, confess as follows:
Heavenly Father, I am not aware of any sins, but because of the Blood of Jesus, I receive forgiveness and cleansing from the unknown ones. In the Name of Jesus, I renounce satan and every devil and evil spirit behind all of my sins. In the Name of Jesus, I invite the Holy Spirit to fall afresh on me and I loose the will of my Heavenly Father and His angels into my life and all that concerns me.
 - c) Forgiving Others.
 - 1) If you have the slightest doubt that you may have been offended, forgive the person: Heavenly Father, in the Name of Jesus, from my heart, I forgive _____ (or every person) who has offended me and I pray blessings on himr.
 - 2) If the memory of a previous offense comes to mind, treat the memory as a sin, pray:
Heavenly Father, I have already forgiven this person, so this memory is a temptation from the enemy and I confess it as a sin and renounce the devils and spirits behind it.
