

Life Defining Decisions

Overview: Your past and current Life Defining Decisions will determine your future, which includes whether you will live and remain or whether you will die; and will also affect your outcome in the Millennium after the Rapture. The effects of these decisions are just as eternal as your decision to ask Jesus into your heart.

- A. Life Defining Decisions Are Made by the WOG or Inquiring of the Holy Spirit.** Rom 8:14
- 1) We make 25,000 decisions a day, how many are led by the Spirit of God?
 - 2) Avoid Death Defining Decisions are bad decisions that have catastrophic effects.
 - 3) My people perish for a lack of knowledge (not a lack of faith). Hosea 4:6
- B. Make A Decision To Look To Jesus On The Cross To Rescue You.** Num 21:1-9
- 1) Israelites made a bad decision to complain and were bitten by snakes because of their sin.
 - 2) God answered Moses' prayer because he was not in sin; and told the people to look upon the bronze snake on a pole to get healed, which was a foreshadowing of how we should look to Jesus on the cross for salvation and healing.
- C. What Are Life Defining Decisions (As A Man Thinks in His Heart, So Is He).** Prov 23:7
- 1) Decide to be Born-Again.
 - 2) Decide to prepare for the Rapture and Millennium.
 - 3) Decide to make current decisions which will have a positive affect for eternity.
- D. How The Past Has Influenced Our Current Lives.**
- 1) Do you want a life of security or risk?
 - 2) Do you want to work for yourself with Jesus as your CEO or for a company?
 - 3) Past decisions have brought us where we are.
 - 4) What's more important: living closer to church or your work?
- E. We want to be in the right position when the Lord, Jesus, returns.** 1 Thess 4:17
- 1) Before the Peace with Israel occurs.
 - 2) Before the Temple of Solomon is rebuilt.
 - 3) Before the Stock Market crashes.
 - 4) Before there is World-wide Depression.
 - 5) Before the ending of the Great Apostasy.
 - a. Denominational large churches will come against True Churches led by the Spirit of God, thinking they are heretics and cults.
 - 6) Start laying the foundation of your habits of the life you want when the Anti-Christ comes because he will try to prevent the Return of Jesus and kill Christians and Jews. 1 John 2:18
 - a. A life-style of Fasting & Prayer produces power. Luke 5:33
 - b. Pray in the name of Jesus. John 14:13
 - c. You have power in Jesus when you are Spirit-filled as Super Conquerors. Rom 8:37
 - d. Have thoughts that create decisions that lead to habits that make Life Defining Decisions.

Recommendations: Change your life-style to be planned around a habit of drawing closer to God and completely believe His Word. Start your day like Jesus did to get up early to pray and spend your spare time seeking the Kingdom of God if you want to be prepared for the End Days.
