

The Good Fight

Overview: Our enemy, the devil, is also a thief that does not come except to steal, to kill, and to destroy. However, Jesus has come that we may have life, and have it more abundantly (John 10:10). In order to win a successful battle, we need to know that God is in the details. Knowing that fact helps us to fight the enemy so we can overcome and have an abundant life.

A. Fight the Good Fight of Faith

1 Tim 6:12

1 Tim 6:12 Fight (G75) the good (G4102) fight (G73) of faith (G4102), lay hold on (G1949) eternal life, to which you were also called and have confessed the good confession in the presence of many witnesses.

G75 Strong's Concordance = Greek definition of "fight" is agonizomai, pronounced "ag-o-nid'-zom-ahee."

- To contend with adversaries, struggle, with difficulties and dangers, to endeavor with strenuous zeal, strife, to obtain something. G2570 Strong's Concordance = Greek definition of "good" is "kalos" pronounced "kä-lo's."
- Sound, whole, beautiful, excellence, goodness, usefulness, as to be pleasing; surpassing, precious, useful, suitable, commendable, admirable, magnificent.

G73 Strong's Concordance = Greek definition of "fight" is "ag n" pronounced "ag-one."

A place of assembly in which the Greeks assembled to celebrate solemn games (as the Pythian, the Olympian); hence, 2. a contest, of athletes, runners, charioteers.

G4102 Strong's Concordance = Greek definition of "faith" is "pistis" pronounced "pē'-stēs."

Conviction of the truth of anything, belief respecting man's relationship to God and divine things, generally with the included idea of trust and holy fervor born of faith and conjoined with it.

G1949 Strong's Concordance = Greek definition of "lay hold on" is "epilambanomai" pronounced "e-pē-läm-bä'-no-mī."

To take in addition, lay hold of, take possession of, overtake, attain to, to seize upon anything with the hands.
