

Releasing the Glory

A. The Anointing

Luke 5:17 The Anointing is the presence of the Holy Spirit, invisibly awaiting manifestation for a given purpose.

Isa 10:27 The Anointing destroys the yoke of bondage.

Hos 4:6 God's people perish for a lack of knowledge.

So there must be a connection between the anointing and knowledge.

1 John 2:27 But the anointing which ye have received of him abideth in you, and ye need not that any man teach you: but as the **same anointing teacheth you of all things,** and is truth, and is no lie, and even as it hath taught you, <u>ye shall abide in him</u>

B. Faith Filled Words.

Luke 5:24 The Glory of God is the anointing of God made recognizable to the senses by its manifestation for a given purpose.

2 Chr 5:13-14 The Glory Cloud filled the temple and they could not stand. Luk 17:14 And when he saw [them], he said unto them, Go shew yourselves unto the priests. And it came to pass, that, as they went, they

were cleansed.

Mark 11:23 You have what you say.

Common saying: Actions speak louder than words.

Why is that?

Because most words are powered by the mind. In fact, even when Scriptures are spoken from the mind, they are not Faith Filled Words. They are called Mental Assent.

Pro 18:21 Death and life are in the power of the tongue.

Jam 2:17 Faith without works is dead. (It is just mental assent.)

Faith Filled Words are powered from the heart and always result in action (i.e., works).
