

# Overcoming Fear Part 1 – The Enemy of Faith

**Overview:** Faith is believing that God will do what He promised. Fear is believing that the devil will do what he promised.

### A. What Fear Is

- 1. Fear is trust in the devil's word.
  - a. Hebrews 11:1 (AMPC) states that faith is the title deed to God's promise.
    - "Now faith is the assurance (the confirmation, the title deed) of the things [we] hope for, being the proof of things [we] do not see and the conviction of their reality [faith perceiving as real fact what is not revealed to the senses]."
  - b. Do you think fear is the title deed to the devil's promise of what he can do?
- 2. Fear is believing evil reports.

Num 13:32, 14:3, 22, Joshua 2:9-11

- 3. **F.E.A.R.** can be an acronym for  $\underline{\mathbf{F}}$  alse  $\underline{\mathbf{E}}$  vidence  $\underline{\mathbf{A}}$  ppearing  $\underline{\mathbf{R}}$  eal.
- 4. Fear is the voice of a demon (i.e. a temptation). James 1:13-15, 2 Cor 10:4-5

### **B.** How Fear Works

1. Fear attacks your faith. Joshua 1:6-9

a. Fear and faith are like 2 sides of the same coin.

b. Fear not, only believe. Mark 5:36, Luke 8:50

2. Fear tries to introduce doubt and unbelief. Mark 5:40, Luke 8:53, Mark 11:20-24

James 1:5-8 (AMPC), Mark 9:23-24

3. Fear brings the devil on the scene.

a. That which Job greatly feared came upon him. Job 3:25

4. Fear focuses on the problem, not the solution. Col 3:2, Luke 12:22-25, 32 (AMPC)

## C. What Fear Does

- 1. Fear can affect your voice & body (e.g. loss of voice, hair standing up, cold sweats, paralysis.)
- 2. Fear can affect your mind & emotions (e.g. can't think, confusion, panic, depression, dysfunction.)
- 3. Fear can affect your heart.

a. Physically – heart skips, heart attack. Luke 21:26, Psalm 73:26

b. Spiritually – build strongholds, grips the heart, Deut 20:8 (AMPC) ), Gen 42:25-28

can seem like a knife through the heart.

4. Fear tries to control your tongue & life. James 3:8 (AMPC), Prov 18:21

5. Fear tries to put you in bondage. Rom 8:15

a. All of us were in bondage due to fear of death. Heb 2:14, 15

## D. Overcoming Fear

1. Confess sins, including fear. 1 John 1:9

2. Affirm scriptures on fear. Rom 8:15, 2 Tim 1:7,10

3. Repent, Renounce, Break (RRB).

4. Cast out fear. Mark 16:17

5. Trust God & His Word; speak it out. 2 Tim 1:12, Rom 4:21,17

6. Fast, pray & affirm.

7. Guard your heart – 5 senses. Prov 4:23

8. Walk in love – perfect love cast out fear. 1 John 4:18

9. Be anxious for nothing. Phil 4:6

10. Cast your cares upon Him. 1 Peter 5:7 (AMPC)
