

Releasing the Resurrection Power of Christ Jesus into Your Life

Introduction.

- 1. Nothing of the enemy can hurt you. Luke 20:19
- Mar 7:5 Then the Pharisees and scribes asked him, Why walk not thy disciples according to the tradition of the elders, but eat bread with <u>unwashen hands?</u> Mar 7:18 And he saith unto them, Are ye so without understanding also? Do ye not perceive, that <u>whatsoever thing from without entereth into the man, [it] cannot defile him;</u> Mar 7:19 Because it entereth not into his heart, but into the belly, and goeth out into the draught, purging all meats?
- The Spirit of Life dwells in you.
 Rom 8:11 The Holy Spirit who raised Jesus from the dead dwells in you.
- The Resurrection Power is in you.
 Eph 1:19 And what [is] the exceeding greatness of his power to us-ward who believe, according to the working of his mighty power,
 Eph 1:20 Which he wrought in Christ, when he raised him from the dead, and set [him] at his own right hand in the heavenly [places],.

A. Spiritual Pathways of Growth.

- Children of God Feed on milk, spirit born again.
 1Pe 2:2 As newborn babes, desire the sincere milk of the word, that ye may grow.
- Adults feed on meat, led by the Spirit,
 1Co 3:2 I have fed you with milk, and not with meat: for hitherto ye were not able [to bear it], neither yet now are ye able.
 Heb 5:12 For when for the time **ye ought to be teacher**s, ye have need that one teach you again which [be] the first principles of the oracles of God; and are become such as have need of milk, and not of strong meat.
- Overcomers feed on strong meat, inherit all things
 Heb 5:14 But strong meat belongeth to them that are of **full age**, [even] those who by
 reason of use have their senses exercised to discern both good and evil.
 Rev 21:7 He that overcometh shall inherit all things; and I will be his God, and he shall be
 my son.
- B. Resurrection Power.
 - 1. You are a new Creation.

2Co 5:17 Therefore if any man [be] in Christ, [he is] **a new creature**: old things are passed away; behold, all things are become new.

Gal 2:20 I am crucified with Christ: nevertheless I live; yet not I, but **Christ liveth in me:** and the life which I now live in the flesh I live by the faith of the Son of God, who loved me, and gave himself for me.

2. We are called to be conformed to His image.

Rom 6:4 Therefore we are buried with him by baptism into death: that like as Christ was raised up from the dead by the glory of the Father, even so we also should walk in newness of life.

Rom 6:5 For if we have been planted together in the likeness of his death, we shall be also [in the likeness] of [his] resurrection:

Rom 8:29 For whom he did foreknow, he also did predestinate [to be] conformed to the image of his Son, that he might be the <u>firstborn among many brethren</u>.



3. You are called to do greater works than Jesus.

Rom 8:11 But if the Spirit of him that raised up Jesus from the dead dwell in you, he that raised up Christ from the dead shall also quicken (*i.e., give life to*) your mortal bodies by his Spirit that dwelleth in you.

Joh 14:12 Verily, verily, I say unto you, He that believeth on me, the works that I do shall he do also; and greater [works] than these shall he do; because I go unto my Father.

- C. Vail of the Temple
 - 1. The Vail in the Tabernacle of Moses.

Exo 26:31 And thou shalt make a vail [of] blue, and purple, and scarlet, and fine twined linen of cunning work: with cherubims shall it be made:

Exo 26:33 And thou shalt hang up the vail under the taches, that thou mayest bring in thither within the vail the ark of the testimony: and **the vail shall divide unto you between the holy [place] and the most holy.**

Exo 26:34 And thou shalt put the mercy seat upon the ark of the testimony in the most holy [place].

2. The Vail in Solomon's Temple.

2Ch 3:8 And he made the most holy house, the length whereof [was] according to the breadth of the house, twenty cubits, and the breadth thereof twenty cubits:

2Ch 3:14 And he made the vail [of] blue, and purple, and crimson, and fine linen, and wrought cherubims thereon.

2Ch 5:7 And the priests brought in the ark of the covenant of the LORD unto his place, to the oracle (*i.e. innermost part*) of the house, into the most holy [place, even] under the wings of the cherubims:

3. The Vails since Jesus.

Mat 27:51 And, behold, the vail of the temple was rent in twain from the top to the bottom; and the earth did quake, and the rocks rent;

2Co 3:14 But their minds were blinded: for until this day remaineth the same vail untaken away in the reading of the old testament; which [vail] is done away in Christ.

Pro 4:23 Keep thy heart with all diligence; for out of it [are] the issues of life.

- D. Partnership.
 - Continuing in (i.e., hearing, believing and doing) the Word softens your heart. Joh 8:31 Then said Jesus to those Jews which believed on him, If ye continue in my word, [then] are ye my disciples indeed;

Joh 8:32 And ye shall know the truth, and the truth shall make you free.

Joh 8:33 They answered him, We be Abraham's seed, and were never in bondage to any man: how sayest thou, Ye shall be made free?

Joh 8:34 Jesus answered them, Verily, verily, I say unto you, Whosoever committeth sin is the servant of sin.

2. Let His words abide in you.

Exo 7:14 And the LORD said unto Moses, Pharaoh's heart [is] hardened, he refuseth to let the people go

Joh 15:7 If ye abide in me, and my words abide in you, ye shall ask what ye will, and it shall be done unto you.

3. Parting the Vail allows God to fill your entire being including your body.

Joh 16:13 Howbeit when he, the Spirit of truth, is come, he will guide you into all truth: for he shall not speak of himself; but whatsoever he shall hear, [that] shall he speak: and he will shew you things to come.

Eph 3:19 And to know the love of Christ, which passeth knowledge, that ye might be filled with all the fulness of God.
