Introduction.

- Repetition is mandatory for mental learning.
- Practice is mandatory for heart learning.
- Don't wait for the storms of life to build your house on the solid rock of the Word.
- A. What you learned in S1.
 - 1. Healing belongs to you as made clear in the Story of Healing.
 - 2. How to confess your sins and the four components of sin.
 - 3. The Prayer of Faith is the foundation of all prayers (Mark 11:24).
 - 4. Affirmations (Titus 3:8) and Faith Action Plans (FAP).
 - 5. Breaking curses and casting out demons.
 - 6. What Prayer is:
 - a) Prayer is bringing God's promise back to Him.
 - b) You release God's power in your life through prayer.
 - c) His power is in His Word. Pray His Word.
- B. How you should be living today.
 - 1. Be a loving, forgiving person (Matt 18:35).
 - 2. Confess sins and cast out demons behind the sins (1 John 1:9).
 - 3. Have praise and worship be a part of your day, not just listening but singing along.
 - 4. Make the praying of affirmations an integral part of your lifestyle.
 - 5. Receive Communion at least once per day.
 - 6. Note: Items 2 5 are called Mini-scenarios when you do them as a group. The effect is synergistic (i.e., doing them as a group is much more effective and powerful than the result of doing them individually at different points in time). It is like launching a rocket-propelled grenade compared to firing several rifle shots.
- C. Why go to Semester 2?
 - 1. The Christian lifestyle is like driving a car up a hill without brakes: you cannot stop nor coast because you will roll backwards, so you must continue upwards.
 - 2. Victorious Christian living is walking in the promises of God. Firstly, you have to know the promises in order to walk in them.
 - 3. Continuing in Healing School will help you to become more fluent in Christianese.
 - Semester 2 will help you to grow in your expertise of receiving and ministering healing as shown by the Themes of Healing Schools: Semester 1 Healing comes from speaking the Word of God. Semester 2 Healing comes through the Fruit of the Spirit. Semester 3 Healing comes through Cleansing.
 - 5. Jam 4:7 Submit yourselves therefore to God. Resist the devil, and he will flee from you. The three steps in these three phrases are implemented via the three themes.
 - 6. A person once asked us, "Why are you creating a Bible College if you have a Healing School?" The answer is the same as for the questions, "Why have HS Semester 2 or why go to Semester 2?". We continue to draw closer to God by walking in more and more obedience. We can do this only by acquiring more knowledge of the Word and by acting on what we have learned.



- D. Living until Jesus returns.
 - 1. Luk 21:36 Watch ye therefore, and pray always, that ye may be accounted worthy to escape all these things that shall come to pass, and to stand before the Son of man.
 - 2. Jam 4:8 Draw nigh to God, and he will draw nigh to you. Cleanse [your] hands, [ye] sinners; and purify [your] hearts, [ye] double minded.
 - 3. Healing School Semesters 1, 2 and 3 resulted from the spiritual knowledge and life experiences (i.e., hearing and doing the Word) which have enabled Pastor Joshua to live healthily over the last 45 years without doctors, hospitals and medicines.
 - 4. Gal 3:26 For ye are all the children of God by faith in Christ Jesus. Children feed on the milk of the Word.
 1Pe 2:2 As newborn babes, desire the sincere <u>milk</u> of the word, that ye may grow thereby:
 - Rom 8:14 For as many as are led by the Spirit of God, they are the sons of God. 1Co 3:2 I have fed you with milk, and not with meat: for hitherto ye were not able [to bear it], neither yet now are ye able.
 - 6. Rev 21:7 He that **overcometh** shall inherit all things; and I will be his God, and he shall be my son.

Heb 5:14 But <u>strong meat</u> belongeth to them that are of full age, [even] those who by reason of use have their senses exercised to discern both good and evil.
