

Get Excited About Impossible

All things are possible when the “but” is in the right place

2 Cor 4:18: While we look not at the things which are seen, but at the things which are not seen: for the things which are seen are **temporal**; but the things which are not seen are eternal.

Temporal = Subject to Change

A. Stop Looking at the Seen as Unchangeable (2 Cor 5:7)

- The Sun comes up and the sun goes down.... BUT one day Josh 10:12-14
- The Furnace was 7 times hotter..... BUT then Dan 3:10-30
- The Lions looked fierce and hungry.... BUT then Dan 6:1-28
- Feeding over 15,000 looked impossible.... BUT Jesus John 6:1-13
- We were dead in our trespasses and sins.... BUT God Eph. 2:1-4
- Dr. said the brain tumor was incurable, 2 weeks to live.... BUT
- Jerry Savelle – Dr. said impossible.... BUT six weeks later

With men this is impossible; but with God all things are possible. Matt 19:26

B. How to Change the Seen

1. Know God’s promises. Hos 4:6; Prov 4:20-21
One cannot have faith for that which they are unsure God has promised.
 - More knowledge of God = Multiplied Grace. 2 Pet 1:2-4
 - God gives grace to the humble; receive the Word with meekness. Jas. 4:6; Jas 1:21
2. Know that, in Christ, God has already provided victory. 2 Cor 1:20
2Co 1:20 For all the promises of God in him are yea, and in him Amen, unto the glory of God by us.
3. The promises of God are appropriated by faith.
 - Without faith it is impossible to please God and receive Heb 11:6
 - Faith is the assurance of our confident expectation. Heb 11:1 MEB
4. Believe Mark 11:22-24
Mar 11:22 And Jesus answering saith unto them, Have faith in God.
Mar 11:23 For verily I say unto you, That whosoever shall say unto this mountain, Be thou removed, and be thou cast into the sea; and shall not doubt in his heart, but shall believe that those things which he saith shall come to pass; he shall have whatsoever he saith.
Mar 11:24 Therefore I say unto you, What things soever ye desire, when ye pray, believe that ye receive them, and ye shall have them.
 - a. Jesus believed we could move a mountain with our faith as He spoke, with His faith, the principle into existence.
 - b. Moving the mountains is a result of our believing in our heart (not doubting) what we say.
 - c. How much faith? That of a grain of mustard seed. Matt 17:20
 - d. What kind of faith? The pure faith in God without fear, doubt or unbelief.
 - e. What is the whatsoever that the whosoever can have? – what things you *desire* – place a demand on, pray and believe. *Aiteo* (G154) – to ask, strictly a *demand* of something due. (cf John 14:14)
 - f. Our part is to believe (act and speak), His part is to make possible the impossible.
 - g. **When** is not promised, however the manifestation of the things desired, prayed and believed are promised. Therefore focus on the believing and the manifestation will come.
5. Speak the Word of God over it (affirmations) until it changes. Titus 3:8; Eph 6:17
6. Actions and words must be in conjunction with our faith. James 2:17

C. Walking on the Sea of the Impossible.

1. Keep your eyes on Jesus. Matt 14:25-32

Mat 14:25 And in the fourth watch of the night Jesus went unto them, walking on the sea.
Mat 14:26 And when the disciples saw him walking on the sea, they were **troubled (fear)**, saying, It is a spirit; and they cried out **for fear**.
Mat 14:27 But straightway Jesus spake unto them, saying, Be of good cheer; it is I; **be not afraid**.
Mat 14:28 And Peter answered him and said, Lord, **if it be thou (doubt)**, bid me come unto thee on the water.
Mat 14:29 And he said, Come. And when Peter was come down out of the ship, he walked on the water, to go to Jesus. (***focused on Jesus***)
Mat 14:30 But when he saw the wind boisterous, **he was afraid**; and beginning to sink, he cried, saying, Lord, save me.
Mat 14:31 And immediately Jesus stretched forth his hand, and caught him, and said unto him, O thou of little faith, wherefore didst thou **doubt**?
Mat 14:32 And when they were come into the ship, the wind ceased.

 - Don't give up
 - Don't settle
 - Don't compromise
 - Don't get complacent

2. Don't mix up the Possible with the Impossible.
 - a. With men it is impossible, but with God all things are possible. Matt 19:26; Mar 10:27

Mat 19:26 But Jesus beheld them, and said unto them, With men this is **impossible**; but with God all things are **possible**.
 - b. Nothing shall be impossible to you. Matt 17:20

Mat 17:20 And Jesus said unto them, Because of your unbelief: for verily I say unto you, If ye have faith as a grain of mustard seed, ye shall say unto this mountain, Remove hence to yonder place; and it shall remove; and nothing shall be **impossible** unto you.
 - c. For with God nothing shall be impossible. Luke 1:37

Luk 1:37 For with God nothing shall be **impossible**.
 - d. If you can believe, all things are possible to him that believes. Mark 9:23

Mar 9:23 Jesus said unto him, If thou canst believe, all things are **possible** to him that believeth.
 - e. We can do all things through Christ which strengthens us. Phil 4:13

Php 4:13 I can **do all things** through Christ which strengtheneth me.

The Impossible means that God is about to show up – BE EXCITED

Note: The power of God comes from your Spirit into your Heart when you believe and act on the Word of God. Out of the abundance of the heart the mouth speaks changing the circumstances.
