Overview: Since the greatest commandment in the Law is to love God with all your heart and soul and mind, it behooves us to know what they are.

A. Problems with the Dichotomy

1. Man is a body with a spirit/soul.

2. Using spirit/soul interchangeably creates contradictions.

3. You are made in the image of God, Who is a spirit.
4. You are a spirit which can die, but you have a soul which you can lose.
5. You are a spirit which must be born again, John 3:3

but you have a soul which must be restored. Psalm 23:3
6. In your patience, you must possess your soul; Luke 21:19

therefore, you must be different from your soul.

7. You are the inner man, the spirit man. Eph 3:16; 2Co 4:16; Ro 7:22 Rom 8:11; 1 Cor 3:16; 6:19

because you are sin-free, the righteousness of God. 2 Cor 5:21

9. But your soul has sin. Ps 41:4; Prov 19:15

B. Problems with the Trichotomy

1. Spirit/soul/body ignores the heart and mind.

2. Using spirit/heart interchangeably creates contradictions.

3. Spirit is sin-free but,

if iniquity in heart, God can't hear you. Psalm 66:18; 1 John 3:20

4. Spirit speaks to God and your mind but,

out of the abundance of heart, the mouth speaks. Matt 12:34

5. Assuming the mind is part of the soul

creates contradictions. Matt 22:37

6. The Lord can deliver/restore your soul but Psalm 6:4; 19:7; 23:3

you must renew your mind. Rom 12:2

7. The soul can be delivered by God through the Word, Ps 120:2; Jam 1:21

but the mind must be trained to think on good things. Phil 4:8





Conclusion: The temple has 5 parts. It has been patterned after man, so man has 5 parts. To the Trichotomy above, we must add heart and mind.



SOLOMON'S TEMPLE






THE LATTER HOUSE

Pentachotomy Prayers

A. Prayer for the Heart

Father, I pray in the Name of Jesus that on a daily basis You would continue to manifest the blessings of the following promises of Your Word in my life and that You would help me to guard my heart with all diligence for out of it flow the issues of life (Pro 4:23). I ask that You grant the desires of my heart (Ps 37:4) by letting the meditations of my heart and the words of my mouth be acceptable unto You (Ps 19:14). Create in me a pure (Ps 51:10) and perfect heart (2 Chron 16:9). Heal my broken heart (Luke 4:18) that it may be undividedly (Ps 86:11) loyal to You. Purge my heart with the fire of Your love. Shed more of Your love into my heart and strengthen me by Your Spirit in my inner man that Christ may dwell in my heart (Eph 3:17). Soften the stony ground of my heart with Your compassion and mercy that I may see in all others the glory of my King.

B. Prayer for the Soul

Father, I pray in the Name of Jesus that on a daily basis You would continue to manifest the blessings of the following promises of Your Word in my life and that You would help me to live by the engrafted Word which I have heard, that it may save my soul (James 1:21). I make a decision that I will act daily upon the instruction which I receive from Your Word, from the Holy Spirit and from the anointed teachers of the Body of Christ so as to recover my soul from the snares of the devil (2 Tim 2:26). Help me to live by this decision so that You can restore my soul (Psalm 23:3), that I may dwell in the secret place of the Most High God (Ps 91:1). Grant me Your grace that I may walk in the paths of patience, for in my patience, I will possess my soul (Luke 21:19). Let the words of my mouth flow out of the abundant goodness of my heart (Matt12:34) to keep my soul from trouble (Pro 21:23). Let Your Word light my path (Ps 119:105) by purifying the windows of my soul so that to me everything I see is pure (Titus 1:15).

C. Prayer for the Mind

Father, I thank You that I can call my mind perfect and holy because I have the mind of Christ (1 Cor 2:16). In the Name of Jesus, I declare that I am not conformed to this world but I am transformed by the renewing of my mind that I may prove what is the good and acceptable and perfect will of God (Rom 12:2). In the Name of Jesus, I cast down imaginations and every high thing that would exalt itself against the knowledge of God and I bring into captivity every thought to the obedience of Christ (2 Cor 10:5).

D. Prayer for the Tongue

Father, I pray in the Name of Jesus, that on a daily basis You would put a watch over my tongue lest I sin against Thee (Ps 141:3) and help me so that the words of my mouth and meditations of my heart are acceptable unto Thee (Ps 19:14). Let my heart teach my mouth (Pr 16:23) and I declare that, out of the abundant goodness in my heart, my mouth will speak (Matt 12:34). I choose to speak blessings and not cursings (Deut 30:19). I will bless and not curse (James 3:10). I will avoid every idle word (Matt 12:36) and in the Name of Jesus, all of my words will minister grace to the hearer (Eph 4:29). I have determined in my heart to speak only that which I hear My Heavenly Father speak for, if I do so, my tongue will deliver me (Pr 12:6,13) and will keep my soul from trouble (Pro 21:23). By Your grace, in the Name of Jesus, I will avoid all corrupt communication (Eph 4:29) and will not quench the Holy Spirit (1 Th 5:19).
