

Introduction to the Kingdom of God

Overview:

- 1. The Kingdom of Heaven (KOH) is a place where God lives. All believers will one day join our Heavenly Father in Heaven.
- 2. The Kingdom of God (KOG) is any state where God has dominion and authority. It is any place where God is in control. So the KOG includes the KOH but doesn't include any person/angel (demon) who is exercising free will to be disobedient to God.

Establishing the Kingdom of God

- 1. Confess your sins (1 John 1:9).
- 2. Ask the Holy Spirit to fall afresh upon you (Isaiah 11:2).
- 3. Pray until you are covered with the anointing.
- 4. Ask the Holy Spirit if you should establish His Kingdom in the room.
- 5. Cast all demons, devils and evil spirits out of the room.
- 6. Break the assignments of hell against the meeting and those in it.
- 7. Establish a hedge of protection around the room and bar all interference/distractions.
- 8. Bind all demons, devils and evil spirits which are in the body of any person in the room and command them not to manifest (i.e., influence any person) during the meeting.
- 9. Forgive the sins of each believer in the room (John 20:23, Luke 5:20).
- 10. Pray that the Spirit of God will fall afresh upon each believer in the room.
- 11. Take authority over every thing in the room and establish the Kingdom of God in the room (or around the person for whom you are praying).
- 12. Pray that the Father's will be done in His Kingdom in this room.
- 13. Pray that the Holy Spirit, Rivers of Living Water, will flow out of you and flood the room and the people with the glory/anointing of God (John 7:37-39).
- 14. Release the anointing from within you and continue to do so until the Holy Spirit tells you to stop.

Sample Prayer Below

Heavenly Father,

I pray in the Name of Jesus and in the authority of that Name.

In the Name of Jesus, I repent of every known sin (list them). I turn my back on all sins and I receive forgiveness for all my sins because Your Word promises that, if I confess my known sins, You will forgive me and cleanse me from all unrighteousness. So I declare that my sins have been forgiven and I am covered by the Blood of Jesus. In the Name of Jesus, I invite the Spirit of the Living God to fall afresh upon me right now: the Spirit of Wisdom and Understanding, the Spirit of Counsel and Might, the Spirit of Knowledge and of the Fear of the Lord, making me of quick understanding.

In the Name of Jesus, I bind all demons, devils and evil spirits that are in this room (or building or service) or **on** a body in this room and cast them out of this country into a dry place in a far away country. In the Name of Jesus, I bind all demons, devils and evil spirits that are **in** a body in this room and command them to shut up, be still and not to influence anyone in the room for the duration of this meeting. In the Name of Jesus, I establish a hedge of protection around this room and around every person in the room. In the Name of Jesus, I forgive each person in the room of all their sins and cover each with the blood of Jesus. In the Name of Jesus, I establish the Kingdom of God in this room and pray that the will of Our Heavenly Father be done now in this room. In the Name of Jesus, I invite the Holy Spirit to fall afresh upon each person and to flood each one with the anointing of God. I pray in Jesus' Name that the anointing of God floods this room right now. In the Name of Jesus, I pray that the anointing which is in me will flow out of me and flood the room with the glory of God. In the Name of Jesus, I speak healing anointing and the peace of God upon each person in the room. In Jesus' name, Amen.



Summary Prayer:

In the Name of Jesus (NOJ), I bind every demon, devil and evil spirit in this room (house, property) and cast them out of this country. In the NOJ, I place a hedge of protection around this room and property. In the NOJ, I forgive everyone here their sins and bind every demon, devil and evil spirit and command them to go down and not manifest for the duration of the day. In the NOJ, I pray that the Holy Spirit falls afresh on me and on every person in this room (house, property). In the NOJ. I establish now the Kingdom of God in this place. I pour out of my spirit Rivers of Living Water to flood this place with the anointing and glory of God.

Kingdom of Heaven Scriptures

(32 verses)

Matthew 3:2 And saying, Repent ye: for the **kingdom of heaven** is at hand.

Matthew 4:17 From that time Jesus began to preach, and to say, Repent: for the **kingdom** of heaven is at hand.

Matthew 5:3 Blessed are the poor in spirit: for theirs is the **kingdom of heaven**.

Mark 12:34 And when Jesus saw that he answered discreetly, he said unto him, Thou art not far from the **kingdom of God**. And no man after that durst ask him any question.

Mark 14:25 Verily I say unto you, I will drink no more of the fruit of the vine, until that day that I drink it new in the **kingdom of God**.

Mark 15:43 Joseph of Arimathaea, an honourable counseller, which also waited for the **kingdom of God**, came, and went in boldly unto Pilate, and craved the body of Jesus.

Luke 19:11 And as they heard these things, he added and spake a parable, because he was nigh to Jerusalem, and because they thought that the **kingdom of God** should immediately appear.

Luke 21:31 So likewise ye, when ye see these things come to pass, know ye that the **kingdom of God** is nigh at hand.

Luke 22:16 For I say unto you, I will not any more eat thereof, until it be fulfilled in the **kingdom** of **God**.

Luke 22:18 For I say unto you, I will not drink of the fruit of the vine, until the **kingdom of God** shall come.

Luke 23:51 (The same had not consented to the counsel and deed of them;) he was of Arimathaea, a city of the Jews: who also himself waited for the **kingdom of God**.

John 3:5 Jesus answered, Verily, Verily, I say unto thee, Except a man be born of water and of the Spirit, he cannot enter into the **kingdom of God**.
