

Healing through the Fruit of the Spirit Part 3 Gates of Glory

Overview: Watchman Nee said that a spiritual man is not one that is simply born again but one that is born again and walking in alignment of spirit, soul and body. ABC teaches that the best alignment is one whereby every part is in alignment with all other parts. This occurs when you live in accordance with the Fruit of the Spirit, which is love, joy, peace, patience, gentleness (kindness), goodness, faith, humility (meekness) and self-control (discipline, moderation) Gal 5:22-23. All your parts are in accord, in agreement. This type of lifestyle releases the Glory of God into your life and spheres of influence.

A. Alignment.

1. Spiritual alignment.

Spiritual alignment occurs for you when all of your parts, as defined in the structure of man (i.e., the entire pentachotomy), plus your words (i.e., your tongue) and your works are in agreement with the particular Scripture, the Word of God, which is applicable in the existing circumstances. In other words, your spirit, heart, soul, mind, body, tongue and works are functioning in harmony and agreement. Your entire being is working in one accord.

- 2. Three decision-making parts of man. Since there are only three decision-making parts, the primary alignment is of heart, soul and mind. This gives rise to the expression that "You know that you know that you know." In other words, you know in your heart and you know in your soul and you know in your mind. When this is true, your tongue and works will automatically come into alignment.
- 3. Living by the FOS keeps you in alignment.

Because you love Jesus, you are always trying to live by the Word of God. This means that you are trying to live with your heart, soul and mind in agreement on whatever Scripture is currently the focus of your life. Living piece meal, Scripture to Scripture, can be very challenging. The best way is to live your life by the Fruit of the Spirit (FOS). Treat every violation of the FOS as a sin and CRRB it. You can have great success doing this by starting with a focus on just three parts: Love, Patience and Faith.

B. Releasing Healing Power through Alignment.

Your alignment on the Word of Healing looses Healing Anointing.
Pro 4:22 For they (*the Words of God*) [are] life unto those that find them, and health (*medicine*) to all their flesh.
Pro 4:23 Keep (i.e., guard) thy heart with all diligence; for out of it [are] the issues of life.



 When you are aligned, your words loose Healing Anointing. Mat 12:34 O generation of vipers, how can ye, being evil, speak good things? for <u>out of the abundance of the heart the mouth speaketh.</u>

Mat 12:35 A good man out of the good treasure of the heart bringeth forth good things: and an evil man out of the evil treasure bringeth forth evil things.

Note: A godly man focused on healing will bring forth words of healing out of his heart.3. The Healing Benefits of your justification are loosed by your words.

Mat 12:36 But I say unto you, That every idle word that men shall speak, they shall give account thereof in the day of judgment.

Mat 12:37 For by thy words thou shalt be justified, and by thy words thou shalt be condemned. **Justification.**

The word "Justified" means "just as if you have not sinned". Since without sin there is no sickness, then justification brings healing and health. As you speak the Word of Healing, <u>you begin to live the fruit of your justification</u>, which is that you have been healed by the stripes of Jesus. When you are living in alignment, then the Word of God from your spirit flows sequentially throughout your being to your body to produce healing. This sequence which controls your healing and health is: Spirit, heart, tongue, soul, body (i.e., physical health).

C. Gates of Glory.

1. The Holy of Holies.

In the Temple, God dwelt in the Holy of Holies, separated from the rest of the Temple and the world by the Vail. Once per year, the High Priest entered by parting the Vail and, sprinkled the atoning blood of the sacrifice on the Mercy Seat (Lev 16:14). This obedience to God's directions released God's Glory to cover over the sins of the nation for a year. Note that His Glory was released when the High Priest, all the priests and the people were in one accord, acting in agreement with God's directions for the Day of Atonement, Yom Kippur. Lev 25:9 Thou shalt cause the trumpet of the jubile to sound on the tenth [day] of the seventh month, in the day of atonement shall ye make the trumpet sound throughout all your land.

- 2. The Inner and Outer Man.
 - a) The Inner Man: spirit, heart and soul.

Since the Temple was designed based on the Structure of Man, the same parallel exists when releasing the Glory of God out of yourself. All of God lives in you in your spirit, which is the counterpart of the Holy of Holies. When you part the vail of your heart by accepting the Word of God in any area, God's anointing is released through your heart in that area. The anointing of God for that issue of life in that area is available for use in destroying the yoke of bondage in that area of the Word.

- b) For example, accepting the Word of Healing parts the vail of the heart so that the Spirit of the Lord is present to heal (Luke 5:17). The healing is then activated by an action of faith such as going up in an healing line, believing that you have received, speaking an affirmation, being anointed with oil, etc. (Mark 2:1-12)
- c) The Outer Man: mind, body, tongue and works. To act in one accord, all the parts in the inner man and the outer man must operate in alignment. When the spirit and the heart are aligned, then the tongue will speak from the heart. The words of the tongue guide the soul and as the soul prospers so does the body and finances (3 John 2). When all elements are in one accord, God's anointing is manifested to confirm the Word which has been spoken.



- 3. The Three Gates of Glory.
 - a) The power of being in alignment.

Gen 11:6 And the LORD said, Behold, <u>the people [is] **one**</u>, and they have all one language; and this they begin to do: and now nothing will be restrained from them, which they have imagined to do.

2Ch 5:13 It came even to pass, <u>as the trumpeters and singers [were] as **one**</u>, to make one sound to be heard in praising and thanking the LORD; and when they lifted up [their] voice with the trumpets and cymbals and instruments of musick, and praised the LORD, [saying], For [he is] good; for his mercy [endureth] for ever: that [then] the house was filled with a cloud, [even] the house of the LORD;

2Ch 5:14 So that the priests could not stand to minister by reason of the cloud: <u>for the glory</u> <u>of the LORD</u> had filled the house of God.

Act 1:14 These all continued with <u>one accord</u> in prayer and supplication, with the women, and Mary the mother of Jesus, and with his brethren.

Act 2:1 And when the day of Pentecost was fully come, <u>they were all with **one** accord</u> in one place. v2 And suddenly there came a sound from heaven as of a rushing mighty wind, and it filled all the house where they were sitting. v3 And there appeared unto them cloven tongues like as of fire, and it sat upon each of them.

Act 2:4 And they were all filled with the Holy Ghost, and began to speak with other tongues, as the Spirit gave them utterance.

b) Three Gates and Doors of Glory.

Psa 24:3 Who shall ascend into the hill of the LORD? or who shall stand in his holy place? Psa 24:4 He that hath <u>clean hands</u> (*i.e.*, *body*), and a <u>pure heart</u>; who hath not lifted up his <u>soul</u> (*i.e.*, *via the tongue*) unto vanity, nor <u>sworn deceitfully</u> (*i.e.*, *mind*).

Psa 24:5 He shall receive the blessing from the LORD, and righteousness from the God of his salvation (*i.e., in his born again spirit*).

Psa 24:7 Lift up your heads, O ye <u>gates (i.e., you act as a gate to guard your heart to</u> protect the Glory); and **be ye lift up**, ye everlasting <u>doors (i.e., God acts to release Glory</u> through you as a door); and the King of glory shall come in (<u>i.e., manifest His presence</u>).

Note: Joh 14:21 He that hath my commandments, and keepeth them, he it is that loveth me: and he that loveth me shall be loved of my Father, and I will love him, and will manifest myself to him.

Psa 24:8 Who [is] this King of glory? The LORD strong and mighty, the LORD mighty in battle. v9 Lift up your heads, O ye gates; even lift [them] up, ye everlasting doors; and the King of glory shall come in.

Psa 24:10 Who is this King of glory? <u>The LORD of hosts</u>, he [is] the King of glory. Selah.c) Three decision-makers of Glory.

In the Pentachotomy of Man, there are three decision makers. These are the heart, soul and mind. When these three are in a godly alignment on any issue of life, God's Glory in you is available to come out of you. When these three are in accord with the tongue and works, God's Glory is manifested.

When you <u>live by the Fruit of the Spirit</u>, all seven parts are in one accord and you dwell in the secret place of the Most High God, resulting in the ongoing release of God's Glory and producing for you a lifestyle of miracles, signs and wonders.



d) Living in the Glory from within.

<u>Joh 10:17</u> Therefore doth my Father love me, because <u>I lay down my life</u>, that I might take it again. v18 <u>No man take it (i.e., my life) from me</u>, but I lay it down of myself. I have power to lay it down, and I have power to take it again. This commandment have I received of my Father.

Luk 4:28 And all they in the synagogue, when they heard these things, were filled with wrath,

Luk 4:29 And rose up, and thrust him out of the city, and led him unto the brow of the hill whereon their city was built, that they might cast him down headlong.

Luk 4:30 But he passing through the midst of them went his way,

Act 19:11 And God wrought special miracles by the hands of Paul:

Act 19:12 So that <u>from his body were brought unto the sick handkerchiefs</u> or aprons, and the diseases departed from them, and the evil spirits went out of them.

D. Ministering with Glory.

1. When aligned, the Gates release Glory to others.

Act 5:15 Insomuch that they brought forth the sick into the streets, and laid [them] on beds and couches, that at the least the <u>shadow of Peter</u> passing by might overshadow some of them. Act 5:16 There came also a multitude [out] of the cities round about unto Jerusalem, bringing sick folks, and them which were vexed with unclean spirits: and <u>they were healed every one</u>.

2. When aligned, the Glory is released without your being aware of it. Act 28:3 And when Paul had gathered a bundle of sticks, and laid [them] on the fire, there came a viper out of the heat, and fastened on his hand.

Act 28:4 And when the barbarians saw the [venomous] beast hang on his hand, they said among themselves, No doubt this man is a murderer, whom, though he hath escaped the sea, yet vengeance suffereth not to live.

Act 28:5 And he shook off the beast into the fire, and <u>felt no harm</u>.

Act 28:6 Howbeit they looked when he should have swollen, or fallen down dead suddenly: but after they had looked a great while, and saw no harm come to him, they changed their minds, and said that he was a god.

3. When aligned, the Glory supersedes physical laws.

Act 8:5 Then Philip went down to the city of Samaria, and preached Christ unto them. Act 8:6 And the people with one accord gave heed unto those things which Philip spake, hearing and seeing the miracles which he did.

Act 8:7 For unclean spirits, crying with loud voice, came out of many that were possessed [with them]: and many taken with palsies, and that were lame, were healed.

Act 8:8 And there was great joy in that city.

Act 8:38 And he commanded the chariot to stand still: and they went down both into the water, both Philip and the eunuch; and he baptized him.

Act 8:39 And when they were come up out of the water, the Spirit of the Lord caught away Philip, that the eunuch saw him no more: and he went on his way rejoicing.

Act 8:40 But Philip was found at Azotus:

Suggestion: Decide to live by the Fruit of the Spirit. Start with Joy, Peace and Patience as your spiritual thermostats. CRRB whenever you start to lose even a little bit of any one of the three.
