

Walking in the Anointing

Overview: We walk in the anointing of God when the anointing of the Rivers of Living Water within us flows through a pure heart to merge with the anointing of the Spirit of the Lord resting and remaining upon us. Living in this combined flow from the two sources of the anointing not only keeps us protected and in health but also releases power to change the environment around us and to heal others around us.

A. Two Flows of the Anointing

1. The Anointing in You.

Rivers of Living Water, which refer to the Holy Spirit and His anointing, should flow out of you.

a) The Rivers of Living Water flow out of your spirit.

You are the temple of God. The Spirit of God dwells in you.

1 Cor 3:16

Out of your belly shall flow **rivers of Living Water**.

John 7:39

Joh 7:37 In the last day, that great [day] of the feast, Jesus stood and cried, saying, If any man thirst, let him come unto me, and drink.

Joh 7:38 He that believeth on me, as the scripture hath said, out of his belly (*i.e., inner man*) shall flow rivers of living water.

Joh 7:39 (But this spoke he of the Spirit, which they that believe on him should receive: for the Holy Ghost was not yet [given]; because that Jesus was not yet glorified.)

b) You release the Anointing and the Rivers by speaking.

The Holy Spirit confirms the speaking of the Word.

Mark 16:20

All the issues of life flow from your heart (*i.e., spiritual, not physical*).

Prov 4:23

Pro 4:23 Keep thy heart with all diligence; for out of it [are] the **issues of life**.

The heart teaches the tongue.

Prov 16:23

Death and life are in power of the tongue.

Prov 18:21

A wholesome tongue is a tree of life.

Prov 15:4 KJV, Ampl

The tongue guides the soul.

Pro 21:23; 6:2; Jm 3:2, 8

c) The benefits of the Anointing in you are primarily for you.

You prosper and are in health as your soul prospers.

3 John 2

You are sealed with the Spirit of God.

Eph 4:30

God is life. Jesus is life.

John 14:6

The Holy Spirit pumps life into your mortal flesh.

Rom 8:11

Rom 8:11 But if the Spirit of him that raised up Jesus from the dead dwell in you, he that raised up Christ from the dead **shall also quicken (*i.e., give life to*)** your mortal bodies by his Spirit that dwelleth in you.

You are filled with the **fulness of God** when walking in love.

Eph 3:19

As you continue to walk in the Fruit of the Spirit, the Rivers of Living Water flow through your heart and the Life of God floods your entire being, bringing health and wholeness to every cell, organ and system in your body including your head.

2. The Anointing on You

See His Glory come down on you as the Spirit of God falls afresh on you and remains on you.

- a) The Spirit of the Lord falls on the believer for power. Acts 1:8
 Act 1:8 But ye shall receive power, after the Holy Ghost is come upon you: and ye shall be witnesses unto me.
 Luk 4:1 Jesus being full of the Holy Ghost returned from Jordan, and was led by the Spirit into the wilderness, being forty days tempted of the devil.
The Spirit of the Lord fell upon them. Acts 2:4
 Act 2:4 And they were all filled with the Holy Ghost, and began to speak with other tongues, as the Spirit gave them utterance.
 Have you received the Holy Spirit since you believed? Acts 19:2, 6
- b) The Spirit upon you is primarily for miraculous ministry to others.
 Elijah's heavenly fire burnt the sacrifice & he killed Baal's prophets. 1 Kings 18
 Elisha declared the famine would end in 1 day. 2 Kings 6 & 7 esp 7:1
 Stephen, full of faith and power, did great wonders and miracles. Act 6:8
 Peter's shadow passing over them resulted in their healing. Acts 5:15
 Paul raised the dead man who fell from the third loft. Acts 20:9
- c) The Spirit upon you can also provides miraculous ministry to you with signs and wonders.
 Moses face shone (Ex 34:35); Stephen's face like an angel's. Acts 6:15
 Act 7:55 But he (*Stephen*), being full of the Holy Ghost, looked up steadfastly into heaven, and saw the glory of God, and Jesus standing on the right hand of God.
 They knew that God would translate Elijah, from place to place. 1 Ki 18:12
 1Ki 18:12 And it shall come to pass, [as soon as] I am gone from thee, that the Spirit of the LORD shall carry thee whither I know not; and [so] when I come and tell Ahab, and he cannot find thee, he shall slay me.
 Philip was also translated. Acts 8:39
 Act 8:39 And when they were come up out of the water, the Spirit of the Lord caught away Philip, that the eunuch saw him no more: and he went on his way rejoicing. Act 8:40 But Philip was found at Azotus:
- d) The key for the Anointing is the Spirit abiding and remaining. John 1:32, 33
 If you abide in me and My Words, you shall ask what you will. John 15:7
 The engrafted Word (i.e., the Word in your heart) saves your soul. James 1:21
 The more your soul has been restored is the less you will sin and the more the Spirit will remain upon you without leaving. The more you walk in the Fruit of the Spirit is the more your soul will be restored.
He is Jehovah Macbaseb. We make a choice to dwell in Him. Ps 91
 Psa 91:1 He that dwelleth in the secret place of the most High shall abide under the shadow of the Almighty.
 Psa 91:7 A thousand shall fall at thy side, and ten thousand at thy right hand; [but] it shall not come nigh thee.
 Psa 91:8 Only with thine eyes shalt thou behold and see the reward of the wicked.
 Psa 91:9 Because thou hast made the **LORD**, [which is] **my refuge**, (*Jehovah Macbaseb*) (*pronounce as Makh-as-eh*) [even] the most High, **thy habitation**; v10 There shall no evil befall thee, neither shall any plague come nigh thy dwelling.

B. Stay in the Kingdom of God

1. Let the Word of God flow through you.
 - a) The anointing flows are supported by a third process, which is the flow of the Word of God within you.
 - b) The Word enters the mind by hearing; the Word then flows from the mind into the heart when we act upon it.
 - c) The Word flows from the heart to the tongue; and the spoken Word changes the soul. The soul is the window to your desires in the world.
 - d) So: No Word, No Flow. No Flow, No Anointing.
2. Operate in the KOG.
 - a) Seek ye first the KOG and His righteousness. Matt 6:33
 - b) The KOG is within you. Luke 17:21
 - c) Fear not, for it is your Father's good pleasure to give you the kingdom. Luke 12:32
 - d) Thy kingdom come; Thy will be done. **Declare it with authority.** Matt 6:10
 - e) KOG is Righteousness, Peace and Joy. Romans 14:17
 - f) So live in the Fruit of the Spirit. Gal 5:22-23

C. Praying for the Flows of the Anointing

1. Prayers for the Holy Spirit to fall afresh upon you and to remain on you:
 - a) Pray the Spirit of the Lord is on me. Isa 11:2
 In the Name of Jesus, the Spirit of the Lord is upon me: the Spirit of Power and Might, the Spirit of Wisdom and Understanding, the Spirit of Counsel and Might, the Spirit of Knowledge and of the Fear of the Lord, giving me quick (*life-giving*) understanding of the Fear of the Lord and of all circumstances of life; and bringing back to my memory short, medium and long term, everything that I need for life and godliness for, in the Name of Jesus, I have the mind of Christ.
 - b) Anointed with the Holy Ghost and power. Acts 10:38
 This prayer only works for Spirit filled believers, who have the evidence of speaking in tongues.
 Pray: In the Name of Jesus, I am anointed with the Holy Ghost and power.
 - c) In the Name of Jesus, I reckon myself dead to sin but living in the Fruit of the Spirit (FOS) – love, joy, peace, patience, gentleness, goodness, faith, humility and self-control (discipline).
2. Prayers for the Anointing to flow through you:
 - a) Refer: SOM Module 5 – Prayers for heart, soul, mind and tongue.
 - b) Pray regularly: In the Name of Jesus, Rivers of Living Water flow out of my spirit and saturate my heart, soul, mind, brain, memory, five senses, and every cell organ and system in my body and head, healing, restoring and rejuvenating each and every part of me. John 7:37-39
 - c) After CRRBing, on a regular basis, cleanse your environment by casting out DDEs, then re-establish the Kingdom of God around you.

Suggestion: Pray all the prayers above in Section C on a regular basis.
