5.	Look not at the things which are seen.	2 Cor 4:17-18
6.	Without faith it is impossible to please Him: for he that cometh	
	to God must believe that he is and he is a rewarder of them that	
	diligently seek him.	Heb 11:6
7.	So now faith cometh by hearing, and hearing by the Word of God.	Rom 10:17

3.	If thou canst believe, all things are possible.	Mark 9:23

5.	Now unto him that is able to do exceeding, abundantly above all	
	that we ask or think, according to the power that worketh in us.	Eph 3:20
6.	This is the victory that overcomes the world, even our faith.	1 John 5:4-5
