- 2. Boldness is mandatory. Acts 4:29
- 3. Jesus is our example and He was filled with the Holy Spirit and prayed in other tongues.
- 4. Praying and fasting were necessary for Jesus. Mark 9:15-29

ABC Salvation Prayer to Accept Jesus as Savior

Dear Heavenly Father, in the name of Jesus,

I believe Jesus is the Son of God. I believe Jesus came to earth and died for me on the cross and shed His blood for my salvation. I believe that Jesus rose from the dead and ascended on high. I believe in You, Jesus, as my Lord and Savior; and You are coming back again to earth to reign as my King.

Dear Jesus, I am a sinner. Forgive my sin. The bible says in 1 John 1:9, if I confess my sins, You, God are faithful and just to forgive me of my sins and to cleanse me from all unrighteousness with the precious Blood of Jesus. I repent of all my sins, especially the sin of not accepting You, Jesus, so please come into my heart and give me eternal salvation right now. I give you my heart and my life.

In the name of Jesus, I renounce the legal right of Satan, demons, devils and evil spirits; and they can no longer influence my life. I bind Satan, demons, devils and evils spirits, and they can no longer affect me or anything that concerns me like my body, health, my finances, my family. I am Yours forever, God, and I will serve You and follow You all the rest of my days. From this moment on, I belong to Jesus. I no longer belong to Satan, this world, nor to the enemy of my soul. Thank you God for making me born again. Amen."
