A. Monochotomy

- 1. There is just one entity to man: a body with its parts.
- 2. What you see is what you get.
- 3. If you can't measure it, you can't study it.
- 4. No life after death.
- 5. Hedonistic approach to life.
- 6. Conclusion: Cogito, ergo sum. (I think. Therefore, I am.)

B. Dichotomy

1.	There are two entities to man.	Gen 2:7; 1 Cor 15:45
2.	Man is a body with a soul.	Matt 10:28; 16:26
3.	Man is (has) a spirit.	Ps 51:10; 142:3; 31:5; Mark 14:38

4. Conclusion: Man is a body with a spirit/soul.

C. Trichotomy

- 1. There are three entities to man.
- 2. Man is a spirit with a soul and he lives in a body.
- 3. Your whole spirit and soul and body be preserved.4. Man is made in the image of God.5:236en 1:26
- 5. God is (or has) three parts. Matt 28:19; 1 John 5:7
- 6. Conclusion: Soul is the mind, will and emotions.

D. Pentachotomy

- 1. Man is a spirit being, living in a body.
- 2. He has a heart, soul and mind.
