A. Viewers have different perspectives.

1. Denominational Differences.

- a) God does not change.
 - Mal 3:6 For I [am] the LORD, I change not;
 - Matt 24:35 Heaven and earth shall pass away: but my words shall not pass away.
- b) God does not play favorites.
 - Acts 10:34 God is no respecter of persons.
- c) Bible Ages.
 - Eph 2:7 That in the ages to come he might shew the exceeding riches of his grace in [his] kindness toward us through Christ Jesus.
 - Eph 3:5 Which in other ages was not made known unto the sons of men, as it is now revealed unto his holy apostles and prophets by the Spirit;
 - Col 1:26 [Even] the mystery which hath been hid from ages and from generations, but now is made manifest to his saints:
