- Love your neighbor as self. Matt 22:39

Note: Drawing back, retreating, backsliding or moving backwards to a more natural carnal position from a previously held position of faith, gives no pleasure to God; and leaves that person’s soul still in bondage (i.e., the soul has not been delivered by the engrafted Word because if the Word had been engrafted, the person would not have drawn back).
