D. Specific Actions of Deliverance

- 1. Born again, water baptized, spirit filled, pray in tongues a lot.
- 2. Consecration and alignment.
- 3. Confess our sins frequently; renounce and remove legal rights; break ties.
- 4. Bind and cast demons out of our bodies, homes, and lives on a regular basis.
 - Wash our five (5) parts with Rivers of Living Water.
 - Flood with the Blood of Jesus.
 - Pray that the Holy Spirit replaces all evil spirits and occupies their former places.
- 5. Mind, brain and memory
 - Repent of /confess thoughts, memories, fantasies, etc.
 - Repent of /confess the associated emotions, such as pleasure, fear, bitterness, etc.
 - Renounce and remove legal right of demons and evil spirits.
 - Break soul ties, etc., with persons, places, sins, objects, and spirits behind them.
 - Wash with Rivers of Living Water to remove all spiritual and physical connections.
 - Flood with the Blood to heal and restore all physical connections to pre-sin state.
 - Flood with the Holy Spirit so anointing of God occupies all places affected by sin, demons and evil spirits.
