D. Baptism with the Holy Ghost

1. Foundation: Jesus shall baptize with the Holy Ghost. John 1:33
2. Result: Power (You receive power when the Holy Ghost). Acts 1:8
3. Purpose: Ministering the Gospel with boldness, Matt 28:18
More power in prayers, signs and wonders.
4. Where (Major Effect): Mind (Walk by faith, not by sight; those led by Spirit are adult sons). Rom 10:17, Rom 8:14
5. Action: Receive Jesus as the Baptizer in the Holy Ghost and be baptized with the Holy Spirit with the evidence of *speaking in tongues*.

E. Baptism by Water

1. Foundation: We should walk in newness of life. Rom 6:4, Acts 2:38, 8:36
2. Result: Salvation of the body. Gal 3:2-3, 12-13, 21-22
3. Purpose: Walk in health, wealth and all the benefits of our redemption. Matt 8:17, 1 Peter 2:24
4. Where (Major Effect): The body which was bruised. Mark 16:16, Luke 4:18
5. Action: Receive Jesus as your new life.
