

## **Semper Fi, Always Faithful – Part 2**

### **Always Be Ready In Season and Out of Season**

**Overview:** The Body of Christ is the most important army in the history of the earth. Christians should be like the U.S. Marines who are always fighting or preparing to fight spiritual battles so we can get set free from the snares of the devil. The motto of the Marines is *Semper Fi* which is Latin for Always Faithful. Jesus is coming back sooner than most people think. Christians who are “always faithful” will prepare for the Ending of Days by drawing closer to God which results in becoming disciples and being set free from challenges. Therefore, we should always be sharing the Gospel and **always be ready in season and out of season** to minister to others to help them get ready for the End Times season that we are now entering into.

The Bible says that no one will know the day nor the hour of the Return of the Son of Man, Jesus Christ. Jesus said in Matthew 24, <sup>13</sup> But he who endures to the end shall be saved. <sup>14</sup> And this gospel of the kingdom will be preached in all the world as a witness to all the nations, and then the end will come. <sup>21</sup> For then there will be great tribulation, such as has not been since the beginning of the world until this time, no, nor ever shall be.” Jesus wants you to learn this lesson from the Parable of the Fig Tree that <sup>32</sup> you will know (the season) when its branch has already become tender and puts forth leaves, and know that summer is near. <sup>33</sup> So you also, when you see all these things, know that it is near — at the doors! <sup>34</sup> Assuredly, I say to you, this generation will by no means pass away till all these things take place.”

Pastor Joshua is an End Times Prophet whom the Lord is using greatly to accurately navigate us through these turbulent times. We have seen that his prophecies for the End Times have already been coming to pass. It is wise to heed the warnings spoken by God through him to **always be ready** by studying the Book of Revelation and the Time Line in order to be prepared and to learn how to be a disciple of Jesus Christ who is set free and an Overcomer who will inherit all things.

**In Matthew 24 the disciples asked Jesus, <sup>3</sup> “And what will be the sign of Your coming, and of the end of the age?” <sup>4</sup> And Jesus answered and said to them: “Take heed that no one deceives you. <sup>21</sup> For then there will be great tribulation...<sup>27</sup> For as the lightning comes from the east and flashes to the west, so also will the coming of the Son of Man be... “**

**<sup>29</sup> “Immediately after the tribulation of those days the sun will be darkened, and the moon will not give its light; the stars will fall from heaven, and the powers of the heavens will be shaken. <sup>30</sup> Then the sign of the Son of Man will appear in heaven, and then all the tribes of the earth will mourn, and they will see the Son of Man coming on the clouds of heaven with power and great glory.**

**<sup>31</sup> And He will send His angels with a great sound of a trumpet, and they will gather together His elect ...<sup>36</sup> “But of that day and hour no one knows, not even the angels of heaven, but My Father only.”**

**42 “Watch therefore, for you do not know what hour your Lord is coming...**

**44 Therefore you also be ready, for the Son of Man is coming at an hour you do not expect. 45 Who then is a faithful and wise servant, whom his master made ruler over his household, to give them food in due season? 46 Blessed is that servant whom his master, when He comes, will find so doing. 47 Assuredly, I say to you that He will make him ruler over all His goods.”**

**What should we always be ready for in season and out of season?**

**Always be ready** to know what to do and be prepared, for the Seals are about to be opened as it says in the Book of Revelation 6. In addition, shortly thereafter, the end of the Age of Grace will be coming to an end as it says in the Book of Revelation 8; and you will have had to practice long beforehand how to live in the Age of the Rod of Iron. Furthermore, **always be ready** by continuing to study the entire Book of Revelation series taught with deep insight of our Messiah’s Second Coming and learn it well.

**(1 Thess 4:13-17)** <sup>13</sup> But I do not want you to be ignorant, brethren, concerning those who have fallen asleep (died), lest you sorrow as others who have no hope. <sup>14</sup> For if we believe that Jesus died and rose again, even so God will bring with Him those who sleep (died) in Jesus. <sup>15</sup> For this we say to you by the word of the Lord, that we who are alive and remain until the coming of the Lord will by no means precede those who are asleep. <sup>16</sup> For the Lord Himself will descend from heaven with a shout, with the voice of an archangel, and with the trumpet of God. And the dead in Christ will rise first. <sup>17</sup> **Then we who are alive and remain shall be caught up together with them in the clouds to meet the Lord in the air. And thus we shall always be with the Lord.**

The word “**meet**” in 1 Thessalonians 4:17; Matthew 25:1 (a second coming parable) and in Acts 18:15, refers to the custom of people going out of a city to “**meet**” (Greek: *parousia*) a conquering dignitary who has returned, and grandly accompanies him along the remaining distance to the gates of his home city. So we also, with Jesus Christ at His Coming, will go up in the Rapture to “**meet**” **Him and grandly welcome Jesus Christ, the Son of Man, back to the earth, who is returning to reign on the earth and defeat the enemy as stated in the Book of Revelation! So always be ready in season and out of season for Jesus to rule as our King of Kings forever!**

**A. War Covenants.**

1. Fight the good fight of faith preparing for the End Times. 1 Tim 6:12
  - a. Preach the word! **Be ready in season and out of season.** Convince, rebuke, exhort, with all longsuffering and teaching. 2 Tim 4:2 (NKJV)
  - b. Christians should be like the U.S. Marines who are always fighting or preparing to fight.
2. Jesus said to choose life abundantly or choose to have the devil steal, kill or destroy you. Jn 10:10 (NKJV)
  - a. Choose life better than you have ever imagined it. Jn 10:10 MSG

3. You fight an enemy that has already been defeated; so just because they're defeated doesn't mean you stop fighting.
4. You wrestle not against flesh and blood. Eph 6:12
5. You must overcome the god of this world to have dominion over your heart, soul, mind, body, tongue and finances, or the devil will take dominion over you. If you do not have dominion over these you will **not be ready** for spiritual battle. 2 Cor 4:3-4
6. People are being challenged with sickness and disease because of a lack of knowledge in thinking it's a natural occurrence. Hos 4:6
7. When you have a covenant with God, don't break it.
8. Fight to overcome challenges until you get your victory.

## **B. We Proceed from Level to Level.**

1. You go from glory to glory, precept by precept, line by line. Is 28:10
2. Friendship with the world is being an enemy of God. Jas 4:4 (TLB)
  - a. James 4:4 The Living Bible says, you are like an unfaithful wife who loves her husband's enemies. Don't you realize that making friends with God's enemies — the evil pleasures of this world — makes you an enemy of God? I say it again, that if your aim is to enjoy the evil pleasure of the unsaved world, you cannot also be a friend of God.
3. We're in a battle so prepare to fight from level to level.
4. Knowledge sets you free; and IF you continue in Word, the Word will set you free. Is 28:8-10
  - a. If you want to be set free you must become a disciple. Jn 8:31-32
  - b. Grace and peace be multiplied unto you through the knowledge of God, and of Jesus our Lord. 2 Pet 1:2
  - c. If your days are not joyful and triumphant, then you must get more knowledge how to get set free from the lies of the devil.
  - d. Don't oppose yourself by having a lack of knowledge which allows the devil to attack you. 2 Tim 2:24-26
  - e. Take a step towards God so He can take a step towards you. Jas 4:8
  - f. Speaking the Word of God through affirmations is doing level to level spiritual warfare using the Sword of the Spirit, which is the Word of God. Titus 3:8
  - g. Faith must be released through action and word. Eph 6:17  
Mk 11:22-25
  - h. The Word of God changes us from glory to glory. 2 Cor 3:18

### C. Justified by Your Words.

1. By your words you are justified, out of your mouth. Matt 12:37
2. When demons hear the Word of God it's like pouring hot water on them.
  - a. Pray the Petition Prayer (Prayer of Faith) one time. Mk 11:24  
[Refer to Healing School Semester 1 (HS1)]
3. Then affirm the Word of God many times to see change. Titus 3:8
4. Three steps of the Cycle of Change which sets you free.  
[Refer to Healing School Semester 2 (HS2)]
  - a. Renew your mind by studying the Word of God.
  - b. Deposit the Word of God into your heart by acting on it.
  - c. Speak the Word to set your soul free.
5. What leads you to sin?
  - a. Let me describe for you a worthless and a wicked man; first, he is a constant liar; he signals his true intentions to his friends with eyes and feet and fingers; Prov 6:12-13 (TLB)  
<sup>13</sup> They wink and make gestures to deceive you. Prov 6:13 (GNT)
    - 1) Your tongue leads you to sin because nobody can control his/r tongue except if you give control to the Holy Spirit; and the DDEs (Demons, Devils and Evil spirits) can cause your tongue to lie, be deceitful or be hypocritical.
    - 2) Your eyes lead you to sin because the DDEs can cause your eyes to be deceived and have lust of the eyes. Prov 6:12-13 (TLB) I Jn 2:16
    - 3) Your feet lead you to sin because the DDEs can cause your feet to run to do evil with thoughts of sinning; and wherever you go, the DDEs can leave behind you a trail of misery. Is 59:7 (TLB)
    - 4) Your hand gestures/body language can lead you to sin because the DDEs can cause your hand gestures or body language to be deceitful, have lust of the flesh, or have enticement. Prov 6:12-13(TLB) 1 Jn 2:16 Prov 2:16
6. How to get set free from the sins of the tongue, eyes and feet.
  - a. Break curses over your tongue, eyes, feet and hand gestures/body language. (Refer to Healing School Semesters 2 and HS3)
  - b. Do affirmations for your tongue, eyes, feet and hand gestures.
    - An affirmation for your tongue: Ps 19:14  
**God has made the words of my mouth and meditations of my heart pleasing to Him.**
    - A new affirmation for your tongue: Ps 19:14  
**In the Name of Jesus, God has given to me all the words of my mouth and the meditations of my heart that line up with the Word of God.**

- An affirmation for your eyes: 1 John 2:16 and Eph 1:18  
**In the Name of Jesus, God helps me so I do not lust with my eyes and the Holy Spirit enlightens the eyes of my understanding.**
  - An affirmation for your feet: Is 59:7 (TLB); 2 Peter 1:10; Gal 5:16 (ESV)  
**In the Name of Jesus, God helps my feet to never stumble in sin and helps me to walk by the Spirit of God.**
  - An affirmation for your hand gestures/body language: Prov 6:12-13 (TLB)  
**In the Name of Jesus, God helps me so I do not lust or gratify the desires of my flesh.**
- c. Three Witness (3W), bind up DDEs in your tongue, eyes, feet and hand gestures/body language if you have completed HS1 and HS2.
- If you are a graduate of HS3 then you can cast out and wash out DDEs out of your tongue, eyes, feet and hands (including negative body language DDEs) using the biblical methods taught in HS3.
  - If you are not a HS3 graduate, it is for your own safety that we advise you do not to cast demons out, unless you have been taught through HS3 how to keep the 7 worse demons (worsers) from returning.
- d. Consecrate your tongue, eyes, feet and hand gestures/body language to God.
- Heavenly Father, in the Name of Jesus, I consecrate my tongue, eyes, feet and hand gestures, as well as my body language, to You.

#### **D. Always Faith-filled, Always Be Ready in Season and Out of Season.**

1. *Semper Fidelis* (abbreviated ***Semper Fi***) is Latin for **Always Faithful**.
  - a. It is the motto of the U.S. Marines.
  - b. The Latin word which means faith, faithful and loyal is the same word.
2. <sup>7</sup> And shall God not avenge His own elect who cry out Luke 18:7-8  
day and night to Him, though He bears long with them?  
<sup>8</sup> I tell you that He will avenge them speedily. Nevertheless,  
when the Son of Man comes, will He really find faith on the earth?"
3. Develop all the Fruit of the Spirit to help you to always be ready. However, Faith and Patience are two keys that will really help you to be an Overcomer.
  - a. Here is the patience of the saints; here are those Rev 14:12  
who keep the commandments of God and the faith of Jesus.
4. The Christians who get set free are the faithful ones who attend church
5. *Adeste fideles laeti triumphantes* means O come all ye faithful, joyful and triumphant.
6. *Adeste* is a command which means to go towards God joyfully and and triumphant.
7. Don't wait to increase your commitment towards the Lord.
8. Start by getting out the sins of the eyes because sight accompanies sin.

9. Also get out the sins of your tongue, feet and hand gestures or body language.
10. Prepare by getting set free because the Lord is coming back soon!
11. Guard your heart with all diligence for out of it flows the issues of life; and also guard your eyes. Prov 4:23
12. Jesus prayed, "I do not ask that You will take them out of the world, but that You will keep and protect them from the evil one." Jn 17:15 (AMPC)
13. He who overcomes shall inherit all things, and I will be his God and he shall be My son. Rev 21:7
14. **Always Be Ready In Season and Out of Season** by doing all these things.
  - a. Preach the word [as an official messenger]; 2 Tim 4:2 (AMPC)  
**be ready when the time is right and even when it is not [keep your sense of urgency, whether the opportunity seems favorable or unfavorable, whether convenient or inconvenient, whether welcome or unwelcome];** correct [those who err in doctrine or behavior], warn [those who sin], exhort and encourage [those who are growing toward spiritual maturity], with inexhaustible patience and [faithful] teaching.
