Feb 20 UN WHO declares Novel Coronavirus a Global Health Emergency.

Feb 29 First US COVID-19 death, in Washington state

Mar 2 100 cases reached in the USA

Influenza (Flu). During this current season in the USA, since October 2019, the Flu has infected 32 million people, hospitalized 310,000 and killed 18,000. As of March 13, the number of flu deaths is over 22K.

<u>Note</u>: The mortality rate of the Flu is low, normally 0.1%; in this season it is actually 0.05. COVID-19 at 3.4 (estimated by WHO) is 68 times more deadly than this current Flu strain. For 32 million, 1,224,000 would have died from COVID-19.

Common Question: Why don't they quarantine for the Flu?

Expert's answer is, "To try to quarantine the flu is like trying to harness the wind." Remember the Flu and COVID-19 are transmitted in the same manner with about the same Naught (Reproductive) factor (i.e., 2-3 persons).

D. Forecasts

1. Imperial College study

Financial Times – Shocking Coronavirus Study that shocked the UK and US. New York Times – The Virus Report that Jarred the US and UK to action.

Washington Post – A chilling scientific paper helped upend US and UK Coronavirus strategies.

LA Times – Coronavirus poses terrible choices for global leaders: Wreck your economy or lose millions of lives.

Atlantic – This is how we can beat the Coronavirus.

Results are somewhat comparable to studies by Johns Hopkins, Harvard and UCLA, but the focus here was on stressing the Hospital system.

Summary of Results from Harvard Global Health in LA Times, Mar 18, 2020 Very best case: 20% infected 6 months Hospitals need; strained at 95% Very worst case: 60% infected 18 months Hospitals need 7x more beds.

2. Vox – John Hopkins Chart.

The US curve for the growth of COVID-19 matches Italy.

The curve is exponential.

On Day 18, March 19th, the last (statistical) day on the chart, the US passed Italy with 13,680 deaths

Info from James Robb, MD FCAP

- 1) NO HANDSHAKING! Use a fist bump, slight bow, elbow bump, etc.
- 2) Use ONLY your knuckle to touch light switches. elevator buttons, etc.. Lift the gasoline dispenser with a paper towel or use a disposable glove.
- 3) Open doors with your closed fist or hip do not grasp the handle with your hand, unless there is no other way to open the door. Especially important on bathroom and post office/commercial doors.
- 4) Use disinfectant wipes at the stores when they are available, including wiping the handle and child seat in grocery carts.
- 5) Wash your hands with soap for 10-20 seconds and/or use a greater than 60% alcohol-based hand sanitizer whenever you return home from ANY activity that involves locations where other people have been.
- 6) Keep a bottle of sanitizer available at each of your home's entrances. AND in your car for use after getting gas or touching other contaminated objects when you can't immediately wash your hands.
- 7) If possible, cough or sneeze into a disposable tissue and discard. Use your elbow only if you have to. The clothing on your elbow will contain infectious virus that can be passed on for up to a week or more!
