

The Armor of God Part 2 Living in the Armor

Overview: The armor of God is given so that you can win your spiritual battles. Five parts are defensive; only one is for offensive action; and one can be either, relative to what you choose to do (your works).

(1) THE ARMOR FOR THE SPIRIT, HEART, AND SOUL

- A. Viewing the three as a unit, there is primarily a spiritual orientation.
- B. Each are foundational. Start with Having...
- C. The purpose is getting the Truth, the Word, the Anointing, and the Life out of your spirit through the veil of your Heart to deliver your Soul.
- D. The purpose of the three is primarily defensive to prepare and perfect you.
- E. From the soul onward, the view is outward (physical) manifestation.

(2) THE ARMOR OF GOD – Foundational Pieces.

A. Loins Girt with the Belt of Truth (SPIRIT)

 - a. Loins are the source of life.
 - b. Short metal skirt covering abdomen/pelvis.

(3) THE ARMOR FOR THE MIND, BODY, WORDS AND WORKS

- A. Viewing the four as a unit, there is primarily a physical orientation.
- B. These are for us to take, to seize for ourselves. Taking...
- C. Getting the Truth, the Word, the Anointing, and the Life from the inside of you OUT past your mind via your mouth to control your body and to change the world around you.

- H. The purpose of the two pieces of armor for the Mind and Body (i.e., Faith and Salvation) is primarily defensive to prepare and perfect you.
- I. The purpose of the last two pieces of armor for the Words and Works (i.e., Sword and Praying) is primarily offensive to change circumstances and minister the gospel.

(4) THE ARMOR OF GOD – Operational pieces.

A. The Shield of Faith (MIND)

- 1. Physical
 - a. Shield protects against all attacks of the enemy (e.g., arrows, darts, etc.).
 - b. Shield is the external defense (not attached to you).
- 2. Spiritual
 - a. Shield of Faith protects against fiery darts.
 - b. It is external because your words go forth when you respond to challenges and temptations ("It is written").
 - c. Faith protects the mind as we walk by faith.
 - d. Mind must agree for the dart to take root in the body (e.g., broken foot).



B. The Helmet of Salvation (BODY)

1. Physical

- a. The helmet protects the brain.
- b. Brain damage may limit communication with the world (e.g., vegetable-like).
- 2. Spiritual
 - a. The armor is for the believer; but spiritual salvation (i.e., being born again) is not an issue for believers.
 - b. The challenge is working out your salvation, from the heart out to the body.
 - c. Victory requires the fullness of Salvation; nothing missing, nothing broken.
 - d. You should prosper and be in health even as your soul prospers.
 - e. If you don't know your rights in the fullness of salvation, you can't battle sin, sickness, disease, poverty, and death.
 - f. Damage to the body may limit communication with the world (e.g., comatose or no tongue).

C. The Sword of the Spirit (WORDS)

- 1. Physical
 - a. The Sword is the weapon of offense.
 - b. Requires skill and practice.
- 2. Spiritual

D. Praying Always (WORKS)

- 1. Physical
 - a. Once the armor is on, enter into the battle.
 - b. Fight a good fight for a worthy cause.
- 2. Spiritual

a.	We are sent, delivered, to preach the acceptable year.	Luke 4:19 AMPC
b.	Be purged, sanctified and a vessel of gold for use.	2 Tim. 2:20-21

- c. The first work, the first battle, is praying.
- Eph. 6:18; 1 Tim. 2:1; 1 Cor. 14:1 d. Watch and Pray that you may be able to escape all these things. Luke 21:36

The purpose is getting the Truth, the Word, the Anointing, and the Life out of your spirit through the veil of your Heart to deliver your Soul and then OUT past your Mind via your Mouth to control your Body and to change the world around you.

Suggestions: Affirm: In the name of Jesus, the words of my mouth and the meditations of my heart are acceptable to God. (Psalm 19:14).

> Pray that the anointing of God will flow out of your spirit through your righteous heart to flood your soul with the peace and life of God.
