

Developing Overcomers' Faith Part 6

The Glory in You

Overview: 2Pe 1:4 Whereby are given unto us exceeding great and precious promises: that by these ye might be partakers of the divine nature, having escaped the corruption that is in the world through lust. v5 And beside this, giving all diligence, add to your faith virtue; and to virtue knowledge; v6 And to knowledge temperance; and to temperance patience; and to patience godliness; v7 And to godliness brotherly kindness; and to brotherly kindness charity (LOVE). 2Pe 1:10 Wherefore the rather, brethren, give diligence to make your calling and election sure: for if ye do these things, ye shall never fall:

- A. Developing Overcomers' Faith (DOF) Themes.
 - 1. DOF Part 1 Because of God's grace, we can live not as falling short of the Glory of God but as having been restored to it.
 - 2. DOF Part 2 We grow into this Glory, step by step from the milk of the Word to the strong meat as we mature from children to adults to overcomers.
 - 3. DOF Part 3 We grow along that Straight and Narrow Red Path purchased for us by His Blood.
 - 4. DOF Part 4 We become more conformed to the image of Jesus Christ as we grow from level to level of Glory while progressing thru the 4 ABC Schools.
 - 5. DOF Part 5 Feed and act on strong meat to discern between good and evil.
 - 6. DOF Part 6 Loose the Glory in you by partaking of the divine nature of God through His promises as you love God and your neighbor as yourself.
- B. The Wise Shall Know.
 - 1. Hab 2:14 For the earth shall be filled with the knowledge of the glory of the LORD, as the waters cover the sea.
 - 2. Isa 60:1 Arise, shine; for thy light is come, and the **glory of the LORD is risen upon thee.** v2 For, behold, the darkness shall cover the earth, and gross darkness the people: but the LORD shall arise upon thee, and **his glory shall be seen upon thee.**
 - 3. Dan 12:3 And they that be <u>wise shall shine</u> as the brightness of the firmament; and they that turn many to righteousness as the stars for ever and ever. v4 But thou, O Daniel, shut up the words, and seal the book, [even] to the time of the end: many shall run to and fro, and knowledge shall be increased.
 - Dan 12:9 And he said, Go thy way, Daniel: for the words [are] closed up and sealed till the **time of the end.**
 - Dan 12:10 Many shall be purified, and made white, and tried; but the wicked shall do wickedly: and none of the wicked shall understand; but **the wise** shall understand.



- 4. Heb 5:14 Strong meat belongs to them that are of full age, [even] those who by reason of use have their senses exercised to discern both good and evil.
- 5. Mat 24:24 For there shall arise false Christs, and false prophets, and shall shew great signs and wonders; insomuch that, if [it were] possible, they shall deceive the very elect. Note: We must discern them not by their works but by their Fruit of the Spirit (FOS).
 - 2Th 2:1 Now we beseech you, brethren, by the coming of our Lord Jesus Christ, and [by] our gathering together unto him, 2 That ye be not soon shaken in mind, or be troubled, neither by spirit, nor by word, nor by letter as from us, as that the day of Christ is at hand. 3 Let no man deceive you by any means: for [that day shall not come], except there come a falling away first, and that man of sin be revealed, the son of perdition;
 - 2Th 2:4 Who opposeth and exalteth himself above all that is called God, or that is worshipped; so that he **as God sitteth in the temple of God**, shewing himself that he is God.
- 6. Rev 13:16 And he causeth all, both small and great, rich and poor, free and bond, to receive a mark in their right hand, or in their foreheads: Rev 13:17 And that no man might buy or sell, save he that had the mark, or the name of the beast, or the number of his name. Rev 13:18 Here is wisdom.
- C. The Glory in Them Who Are Alive and Remain.
 - 1. 1Co 15:51 Behold, I shew you a <u>mystery</u>; We shall not all sleep, but we shall all be changed,
 - 2. Col 2:9 For in him dwelleth all the fulness of the Godhead bodily. v10 And <u>ye are complete in him</u>, which is the head of all principality and power: Col 1:27 To whom God would make known what [is] the riches of the <u>glory of this mystery</u> among the Gentiles; which is Christ in you, **the hope of glory:**.
 - 3. Eph 5:26 That he might sanctify and cleanse it with the washing of water by the word, v27 That he might present it to himself a **glorious church**, not having spot, or wrinkle, or any such thing; but that it should be holy and without blemish.
 - 4. Rev 10:7 But in the days of the voice of the seventh angel, when he shall begin to sound, the <u>mystery of God</u> should be finished, as he hath declared to his servants the prophets.
 - 5. 1Jo 3:2 Beloved, now are we the sons of God, and it doth not yet appear what we shall be: but we know that, when he shall appear, we shall be like him; for we shall see him as he is. v3 And every man that hath this hope in him purifieth himself, even as he is pure.
 - 6. 1Th 4:17 Then we which are alive [and] remain shall be caught up together with them in the clouds, to meet the Lord in the air: and **so shall we ever be with the Lord**.
