

## **Liberty with Christ Jesus Made Us Free**

### **A. God Made Us Free and Satan Is Trying to Take It Away.**

1. Stand fast therefore in the liberty by which Gal 5:1  
Christ has made us free, and do not be entangled again with a yoke of bondage.
2. Two of the main concepts of war.
  - a. Cut the supply lines.
    - 1) Corona Virus Covid-19 is cutting our normal supplies.
  - b. Divide and conquer.
    - 1) Racial division, rioting, anarchy, churches being severely affected.
3. Christians do not wrestle against people but demonic entities.
  - a. For we do not wrestle against flesh and blood, Eph 6:12  
but against principalities, against powers, against the rulers of the darkness of this age, against spiritual hosts of wickedness in the heavenly places.

### **B. With Freedom Comes Responsibility.**

1. <sup>15</sup> For it is God's will and intention that by doing 1 Peter 2:15-16 (AMPC)  
right [your good and honest lives] should silence (muzzle, gag) the ignorant  
charges and ill-informed criticisms of foolish persons. <sup>16</sup> [Live] as free people,  
[yet] without employing your freedom as a pretext for wickedness; but [live at all  
times] as servants of God.
  - a. Servants of God bring about responsible freedom in a godly manner.

### **C. Where the Spirit of the Lord Is There Is Freedom.**

1. Now the Lord is the Spirit, and where the Spirit 2 Cor 3:17 (AMPC)  
of the Lord is, there is liberty (emancipation from bondage, freedom).
2. Overcomers of adversity.
  - a. Daryl Davis – a black musician that befriended KKK members. Because of  
him, over 200 have left the Ku Klux Klan.
  - b. Mike Burden testimony – a white man who was the Grand Dragon of the KKK  
got ministered to by a black preacher and left the KKK.
  - c. Mr. Ford and Mr. Lockett's testimonies – These two Christians were unaware  
that Mr. Lockett (a white man) was one of the descendants of a slave owner  
and Mr. Ford (a black man) was the descendent of the slaves that were  
owned. God had given each a dream separately to go to an MLK rally in D.C.  
where they met, became friends, and then prayer partners for 10 years. Only  
then did they discover their family history and forgave the past generational  
bondages of their families and blessed each family with God's love, joy, peace  
and unity.
3. Pray for God's love, joy, peace and unity for our entire country.
