 - Discipline a) Training that corrects, molds or perfects. b) Enforcing obedience or order. c) Bringing under control. d) Imposing order.
 - Self-Control Restraint exercised over one's own impulses, emotions or desires (*plus words, thoughts and actions*).
 - Diligence persevering or consistent, energetic application and effort.
 - Patience a) Steadfast despite opposition, difficulty or adversity.
 - b) Joyful endurance.
