

Positioning Yourself for Warfare

Foundational Scripture: 1Tim 1:18-19; 2:1-8 This charge I commit unto thee, son Timothy, according to the prophecies which went before on thee, that thou by them mightest war a good warfare; 19 Holding faith, and a good conscience; which some having put away concerning faith have made shipwreck: 2:1 I exhort therefore, that, first of all, supplications, prayers, intercessions, and giving of thanks, be made for all men; 2 For kings, and for all that are in authority; that we may lead a quiet and peaceable life in all godliness and honesty. 3 For this is good and acceptable in the sight of God our Saviour; 4 Who will have all men to be saved, and to come unto the knowledge of the truth. 5 For there is one God, and one mediator between God and men, the man Christ Jesus; 6 Who gave himself a ransom for all, to be testified in due time. 7 Whereunto I am ordained a preacher, and an apostle, (I speak the truth in Christ, and lie not;) a teacher of the Gentiles in faith and verity. 8 I will therefore that men pray every where, lifting up holy hands, without wrath and doubting.

D. Warfare Prayer Guidelines.

- 1. Purpose of Warfare Prayers: To bring the Kingdom of God to every place and every sphere of mankind by overthrowing the evil spiritual strongholds influencing mankind and replacing them with the values of the kingdom.
- 2. General Prayer Guidelines:
 - a. Watch: signs of the times in the physical and spiritual (What is satan doing? What is God doing?)
 - b. Hear: Turn from the noisy clamor of the world and focus on the throne to hear the insights and strategies of Jesus and the Father.
 - c. Pray: Decree and command the specifics of Heaven on the earth. The Word of God, the heart of God, the will of God, and the kingdom of God.
 - d. Go and Do: Put feet to your prayers by doing what God has instructed as your part, to carry out your destiny.



3. Strategic Prayers:

- a. All men.
 - Supplications, prayers, intercessions, and giving of thanks.
- b. Leaders.
 - Wisdom, righteousness, justice.
- c. The Church.
 - Five-fold ministers, glorious church, preaching of the Gospel.
- d. Kingdom and the Glory.
 - His kingdom come, His will be done.
 - The axe of righteousness laid against the root of sin and evil.
 - Bind the demons, devils, and evil spirits blinding the minds of people.
 - Make straight His path for the glory of the Lord.
 - Pray for his mercy, for the goodness of God leads people to repentance.
