Be Alive and Remain

Foundational Scriptures:

Mat 22:37 Jesus said unto him, Thou shalt love the Lord thy God with all thy heart, and with all thy soul, and with all thy mind. v39 and your neighbor as self.

Eph 3:19 And to know the love of Christ, which passeth knowledge, that ye might be filled with all the fulness of God.

Eph 5:26 ... As Christ loved the church that he might sanctify and cleanse it (*the church*) with the washing of water by the word, v27 ... himself a glorious church,

A. Christians in the sleep of death.

1. For those who are dead in Christ, Jesus is Lord.

1Th 4:16 For the Lord himself shall descend from heaven with a shout, with the voice of the archangel, and with the trump of God: and the dead in Christ shall rise first:

1Th 4:17 Then we which are alive [and] remain shall be caught up together with them in the clouds, to meet the Lord in the air: and so shall we ever be with the Lord.

Rev 19:11 And I saw heaven opened, and behold a white horse; and he that sat upon him [was] called Faithful and True, and in righteousness he doth judge and make war. v13 ... his name is called The Word of God.

Rev 19:14 And the armies [which were] in heaven followed him

2. For those who are asleep in Jesus, Jesus is Savior.

1Th 4:14 For if we believe that Jesus died and rose again, even so them also which sleep in Jesus will God bring with him.

2Co 5:8 We are confident, [I say], and willing rather to be absent from the body, and to be present with the Lord.

Rev 20:11 And I saw a great white throne, and him that sat on it, from whose face the earth and the heaven fled away;

Rev 20:12 And I saw the dead, small and great, stand before God; and the books were opened: and another book was opened, which is [the book] of life: and the dead were judged out of those things which were written in the books, according to their works.

B. Partnership to be Alive.

1. Love.

Joh 14:21 He that hath my commandments, and keepeth them, he it is that loveth me: and he that loveth me shall be loved of my Father, and I will love him, and will manifest myself to him.

1Pe 2:24 Who his own self bare our sins in his own body on the tree, that we, being dead to sins, should live unto righteousness: ... ye were healed.

Rom 8:2 For the law of the Spirit of life in Christ Jesus hath made me free from the law of sin and death.

2Ti 1:10 Our Saviour Jesus Christ, who hath abolished death, and hath brought life and immortality to light through the gospel:
1Co 15:51 We shall not all sleep (*die*), but we shall all be changed,

2. Diligence.

1 Pet 1:16 Be holy for God is holy.

1 John 1:9 Confess your sins to block the attacks of the enemy.

Titus 3:8 Do Affirmations.

Rom 6:11 Likewise reckon ye also yourselves to be dead indeed unto sin, but alive unto God through Jesus Christ our Lord.

Col 2:9-10 In Christ Jesus dwells all the fulness of the Godhead bodily & I am complete in Him, who is the Head of all principality and power.

Serve God in righteousness, not satan in sin.

Rom 6:16 to whom ye yield yourselves servants to obey, his servants ye are to whom ye obey; whether of sin unto death, or of obedience unto righteousness?

Rom 6:19 yield your members servants to righteousness unto holiness.

Rom 6:22 But now being made free from sin, and become servants to God, ye have your fruit unto holiness, and the end everlasting life. v23 For the wages of sin [is] death; but the gift of God [is] eternal life through Jesus Christ our Lord.

Grace is your safety net.

Rom 8:1 [There is] therefore now no condemnation to them which are in Christ Jesus, who walk not after the flesh, but after the Spirit.

Watch and pray.

Luk 21:36 Watch ye therefore, and pray always, that ye may be accounted worthy to escape all these things that shall come to pass, and stand before the Son of man.

C. Partnership to Remain.

1. Love.

2Co 5:21 For he hath made him [to be] sin for us, who knew no sin; that we might be made the righteousness of God in him.

1Jo 3:3 And every man that hath this hope in him purifieth himself, even as he is pure.

1Jo 3:6 Whosoever abideth in him sinneth not:

1Jo 3:9 Whosoever is born of God doth not commit sin; for his seed remaineth in him: and he cannot sin, because he is born of God.

2. Diligence.

2Th 2:2 ... as that the day of Christ is at hand. v3 Let no man deceive you: for [that day shall not come], except there come a falling away first, (*the Great Apostasy*) and that man of sin be revealed, the son of perdition;

Joh 8:31 If ye continue in my word, [then] are ye my disciples indeed;

Joh 8:32 And ye shall know the truth, and the truth shall make you free.

Jam 4:8 Draw nigh to God, and he will draw nigh to you.

Heb 10:38 Now the just shall live by faith: but if [any man] draw back, my soul shall have no pleasure in him. Luk 18:8 Nevertheless when the Son of man cometh, shall he find faith on the earth?
