Protection Prayers Series – Part 1 God Protects Believers

- A. Do Not Be Afraid; Only Believe. Mark 5:35, 36-43
1. Do not be “afraid” transliterates in the Greek as G5399 “phobeo” which means do not “fear” or do not be scared away.
 2. Merriam-Webster defines “afraid” as “filled with fear.”
 3. “Believe” transliterates in the Greek as G4100 “pisteuo” which means “commit to (one’s) trust.”
 4. Merriam- Webster defines “believe” as:
 - a) To have a firm or wholehearted religious conviction or persuasion: to regard the existence of God as a fact.
(For example: Do you believe? = Do you believe in the Scriptures?)
 - b) To accept something as true, genuine, or real ideals (*a standard of perfection*) we believe in. (For example: Do you believe in ghosts?)
 - c) To have a firm conviction as to the goodness, efficacy, or ability of something. (For example: She believes in regular exercise.)
 5. If you truly believe in your heart that God has answered your prayer when you asked one time, you should be a hearer and a doer to act on it, and speak or affirm it out loud because in the spirit realm it has already been done for you.
- B. Pray Effective Prayers.
1. The effectual fervent prayer of a righteous man avails much. James 5:16b
- C. Pray and Affirm a Scripture That God Has Promised You. Ezek 12:25; Isa 55:11;
Jer 1:12
- D. God Wants to Protect Believers.
1. The Lord will fight for you. Exodus 14:13-14
 - a) ¹³ Moses said to the people, “Do not be afraid. Stand still, and see the salvation of the Lord, which He will accomplish for you today. For the Egyptians whom you see today, you shall see again no more forever. ¹⁴ The Lord will fight for you, and you shall hold your peace.

2. The Lord delivers you from trouble. Psalm 34:19
 - a) Many are the afflictions of the righteous, but the Lord delivers him out of them all.
3. The Lord will not forsake you. 2 Cor 4:8-9
 - a) ⁸ We are hard-pressed on every side, yet not crushed; we are perplexed, but not in despair; ⁹ persecuted, but not forsaken; struck down, but not destroyed.
4. The Lord will be your refuge and protect you. Psalm 91
 - a) Pray Psalm 91 every day upon awakening without fail.
 - b) It is strongly suggested to memorize it by heart.
5. Daily Affirmations to protect you from COVID-19:
 - a) In the NOJ, every COVID-19 virus is killed or destroyed if it comes close to me (*my family, pets, car, or possessions*).
 - b) In the NOJ, every COVID-19 virus that comes in, on or above my (*our family's*) home or property (*business or workplace*) is instantly killed or destroyed.
 - c) (*My family, pets and*) I have been inoculated from COVID-19 by the Blood of Jesus.

Psalm 91 Protection Prayer (*Personalized*) NKJV

**Heavenly Father, in the name of Jesus,
I pray for myself (*and for my family, friends and loved ones*) that daily:**

¹I (*we*) dwell in the secret place of the Most High
(*and*) I (*we*) abide under the shadow of the Almighty.

²I (*we*) say of the Lord, "You are my (*our*) refuge and my (*our*) fortress;
My (*Our*) God, in You I (*we*) trust."

³Surely You deliver me (*us*) from the snare of the fowler
and from the perilous pestilence.

⁴You cover me (*us*) with Your feathers, and under Your wings
I (*we*) take refuge; Your truth is my (*our*) shield and buckler.

⁵I (*We*) am (*are*) not afraid of the terror by night,
nor of the arrow that flies by day,

⁶Nor of the pestilence that walks in darkness,
nor of the destruction that lays waste at noonday.

⁷A thousand may fall at my (*our*) side, and ten thousand
at my (*our*) right hand; but it shall not come near me (*us*).

⁸Only with my (*our*) eyes shall I (*we*) look,
(Only a spectator shall I (*we*) myself (*ourselves*) be inaccessible
in the secret place of the Most High {AMPV}),
and see the reward (*or* punishment {NIV}) of the wicked,

⁹Because I (*we*) have made the Lord, who is my (*our*) refuge,
even the Most High, my (*our*) dwelling place,

¹⁰No evil shall befall me (*us*), nor shall any plague come near my (*our*) dwelling;

¹¹For You have given Your angels charge over me (*us*),
to keep me (*us*) (to accompany, defend and preserve me (*us*) {AMPC})
in all my (*our*) ways (in obedience and service {AMPC}, to protect me (*us*) {TLB}).

¹²In their hands they bear me (*us*) up,
lest (*to prevent that*) I (*we*) dash my (*our*) foot
against a stone (*or stumble {H5062}*).

¹³I (*We*) tread upon the lion and the cobra,
the young lion and the serpent I (*we*) trample underfoot.

¹⁴Because I (*we*) have set my (*our*) love upon You (Lord),
therefore You (*God*) deliver me (*us*);
You set me (*us*) on high (*that You will put me/us up so high
that I/we cannot be captured by the enemy {H7632}*),
because I (*we*) know Your name (*my/our Lord, Jesus Christ*),
(and I (*we*) have a personal knowledge of Your mercy, love, and kindness —
I (*we*) trust and rely on You, knowing You will never forsake me (*us*) {AMPC}).

¹⁵I (*We*) call upon You (*Heavenly Father*), and You answer me (*us*);
You (*Holy Spirit*) are (*always*) with me (*us*) in trouble;
You (*Lord, Jesus*) deliver me (*us*),
honor (*and promote {H3513}*) me (*us*).

¹⁶With long life You (*God*) satisfy me (*us*),
and show me (*us*) Your salvation.
