

## Vaccines and Conspiracies

### Foundation Scripture:

Mat 24:24 For there shall arise false Christs, and false prophets, and shall shew great signs and wonders; insomuch that, if [it were] possible, they shall deceive the very elect.

Heb 5:14 Strong meat belongeth to them that are of full age, [even] those who by reason of use have their senses exercised to discern both good and evil.

### A. Pandemic Current Status.

1. **WW** cases 58M, deaths 1.4M Daily: cases 650K, deaths 11K  
*Estimate*: 2M deaths by 12/31/20. Previous estimate was 1.5M
2. **USA** cases 12M, deaths 261K; Daily cases 200K, deaths 2K  
*Est 1*: cases 21M, deaths 350K by 12/31 at current daily rate.  
*Est 2*: cases 30M, deaths 440K by 12/31 if cases double again.

### B. Vaccines.

1. Pfizer and Moderna are both genetically engineered. Both have about a 95% success rate. Rollout to be within weeks. Cost \$35-45 but free to Americans; very high cost for poor countries. Two shots are needed.
2. AstraZeneca and Oxford University use cloned antibodies a la the Ebola vaccine. Genetic engineering for humanization is done outside of the human body. Cost: about \$3; only 1 shot needed. Available about June.

### C. 2020 and 1918 Pandemic Comparisons.

1. Both pandemics had confrontations about the value of wearing masks. In both pandemics, the country was divided on the danger of the virus. Both had conspiracy theories regarding the origin of the virus. President Wilson ignored it while focusing on the League of Nations. President Trump has downplayed it while focusing on the economy and election. Both presidents became infected.
2. Death tolls.  
1918 - 1919 618,000 deaths in US and 50 -100 million worldwide.  
12/31/2020 350 - 440K in US and 2 million WW. The great hope is the vaccine; 50% in US do not use masks, so will they take vaccines?

### D. The Theory of Conspiracy Theories (CT).

Definition.com

Definition: a belief that some covert but influential organization (*or incident, object, entity*) is responsible for a circumstance or event. *There is no proof.*

1. Early days of the Pandemic.

The pandemic is: germ warfare by China; launched by world rulers to bring in one-world-government; a United Nations plot to inject control chips into people with the application of vaccines; an antichrist plot because Corona matches 666 if you play with the numbers; a result of 5G

towers causing infections; a hoax and people are lying about the deaths and the statistics;

2. Conspiracies today.

Pandemic is like a regular flu but people are exaggerating it to influence the elections; the people behind the pandemic hoax know it is not real so they occasionally slip up and do not wear masks or social distance; the infection and death counts have been greatly exaggerated because the hospitals have few or no Covid cases; it is a plan by Bill Gates to insert brain implants via vaccines; it is created as a biological weapon; it is caused by GMOs; it is manipulated by the deep state; it is a plot by big pharmacies.

3. The Theory of Conspiracy Theories (CT).

a) Most people fall into 3 groups. Two are conspiracy theorists (CTist).

1) Low Education. Many readily accept CT because they do not analyze for themselves but rely on strong group leadership. They also have a need for group consensus and strong social bonding.

2) College graduates: They pay little attention to CT because they are trained to analyze and make independent decisions. They are fact-based, mentally-oriented and view the world through the eyes of rationality, logic, science and medicine.

3) Higher Level Focus. They are open to CT because they have learned to hold beliefs based on instinct, intuition, gut feeling, ESP, alien existence, higher power, spirituality, God, religion, the Bible, other religious books, faith, etc. They have learned not to require proof so they will accept CT, which by definition have no proof.

b) Evidence does not influence CT believers (CTist).

CT believers are, by definition, believers. They believe by faith, so no evidence is required. Therefore, they cannot be changed by evidence.

CTists accept a specific conspiracy belief for many reasons but, by definition, proof is not one of these reasons; else it would be a fact. When confronted with contradicting evidence, CTists simply include the new data/people as part of the conspiracy & ignore the contradictions. CT tend to snowball because the CTists share their theories and coincidental or confirming stories with each other in a love-fest of hate.

c) The spiritual factors of CT.

The most common factors which suck people into CT are hate and fear: hate of a person or thing; fear of how it might affect them. The CTist continues onwards into the sins of judging others; of evil speaking; and of self-righteousness (e.g., I believe that those people do these terrible things and they are not as good as we are). Taking offense and unforgiveness tend to be on-going sins for the CTist.
