#### Review

CED Pt 1 Don't Eat the Fruit. (Live the Fruit). 10/09/2020

### **Foundational Scripture**

Heb 10:14 For by one offering he hath perfected for ever them that are sanctified.

- A. Count Yourself Dead to Sin (Rom 6:11).
  - 2 Cor 5:21 For he hath made him [to be] sin for us, who knew no sin; that we might be made the righteousness of God in him.
  - 1. You are living in the Age of Grace.
    - Rom 5:9 God sees you through the Blood of Jesus (i.e., without sin).
    - Rom 4:15 Where there is no law, there is no sin.
    - **Note**: Under grace, there is no law; so you cannot transgress the law.
    - Rom 3:24 You have been justified; Your sins have been washed away.
    - 1 Pet 2:24 Jesus took your sins in His body on the cross. They are gone.
    - 1 John 3:9 Whosoever (*i.e., the spirit man*) is born of God doth not commit sin; for his seed remaineth in him: and he cannot sin, because he is born of God (*which means he is living under grace*).
    - Rom 5:9 Much more then, being now justified by his blood, <u>we shall be</u> saved from wrath through him. **Note**: God's wrath in the ending days.
    - Rom 5:10 For if, when we were enemies, we were reconciled to God by the death of his Son, much more, being reconciled, we shall be saved by
    - his life. Note: We believers saved from what? Ending Days challenges.
  - 2. Work righteousness from your spirit into your members as holiness. Rom 6:13 Neither yield ye your members [as] instruments of
    - unrighteousness unto sin: but yield yourselves unto God, as those that are alive from the dead, and your members [as] instruments of righteousness unto God.
    - Rom 6:16 Know ye not, that to whom ye yield yourselves servants to obey, his servants ye are to whom ye obey; whether of sin unto death, or of obedience unto righteousness (*life*)?
    - 1John 3:6 Whosoever abides in him sins not: by walking in love (1Jn 4:16).
    - 1John 3:2 Beloved, now are we the sons of God, and it doth not yet appear what we shall be: but we know that, when he shall appear, we shall be like him; for we shall see him as he is.
    - 1John 3:3 And every man that hath this hope in him <u>purifieth himself, even</u> as he is <u>pure</u>.
    - Phi 2:12 .... work out your own salvation with fear and trembling.



#### B. Doctrine of Perfection.

Matt 5:48 Be ye therefore perfect, even as your Father which is in heaven is perfect.

#### 1. What is it?

Heb 6:1 Therefore leaving the principles of the doctrine of Christ, <u>let us go</u> on unto perfection; not laying again the foundation of repentance from dead works, and of faith toward God,

Eph 5:25 .... Christ also loved the church, and gave himself for it; Eph 5:26 That he might sanctify and cleanse it with the washing of water by the word,

Eph 5:27 That he might present it to himself a <u>glorious church</u>, not having spot, or wrinkle, or any such thing; but that it should be holy and without blemish.

Eph 3:17-19 ..... And to know the love of Christ, which passeth knowledge, that <u>ye might be filled with all the fulness of God.</u>

Col 2:9 For in him dwelleth all the fulness of the Godhead bodily.

Col 2:10 And <u>ye are complete</u> (i.e., filled by cramming, perfected) in him, which is the head of all principality and power:

1John 4:16 We have known and believed the love that God hath to us. God is love; and he that dwelleth in love dwelleth in God, and God in him. 1John 4:17 Herein is our love made perfect, that we may have boldness in the day of judgment: because as he is, so are we in this world.

## 2. How do you live it?

Heb 7:25 He is able also to <u>save them to the uttermost</u> that come unto God by him, seeing he ever liveth to make intercession for them. Matt 19:21 Jesus said unto him, <u>If thou wilt be perfect</u>, go [and] sell that thou hast, and give to the poor, and thou shalt have treasure in heaven: and come [and] follow me.

Mark 8:35 For whosoever will save his life shall lose it; but whosoever shall lose his life for my sake and the gospel's, the same shall save it.

1 Cor 3:16 Know ye not that ye are the temple of God, and [that] the Spirit of God dwelleth in you?

1 Cor 3:17 If any man defile the temple of God, him shall God destroy; for the temple of God is holy, which [temple] ye are.

1 Pet 1:15 Be holy for God is holy.

Rev 11:3 And I will give [power] unto my two witnesses, ....

Rev 11:5 And if any man will hurt them, fire proceedeth out of their mouth, and devoureth their enemies: and if any man will hurt them, he must in this manner be killed.



- C. You Have Been Perfected by His Shed Blood.
  - Eph 5:27 Jesus wants to present you to himself as part of the glorious church, not having spot, or wrinkle, ... holy and without blemish.
  - 1. Jesus gave you His perfection through the Blood Covenant. Because of the testament (i.e., covenant) sealed in His Blood, whenever you have a need, you have a legal right to whatever Jesus has. Rom 8:17 And if children, then heirs; heirs of God, and joint-heirs with Christ; if so be that we suffer with [him], that we may be also glorified together. Note: suffer - Strong G4841- experience jointly or sympathize, esp persecution. 2 verses - 1 Cor 12:26 if one suffers, all suffer (honored). Rom 8:29 For whom he did foreknow, he also did predestinate [to be] conformed to the image of his Son, that he might be the firstborn among many brethren. v30 Moreover whom he did predestinate, them he also called: and whom he called, them he also justified: and whom he justified, them he also glorified.
    - 1 Cor 6:11 ....ye are washed, but ye are sanctified, but ye are <u>justified</u> in the name of the Lord Jesus, and by the Spirit of our God.

      John 11:26 And whosoever liveth and believeth in me shall never die.
  - 2. Your partnership is to receive the gift of perfection.
    - Luke 4:18 Jesus came to give your spirit new birth, to heal your heart, save your soul, renew your mind and heal your body (HS Semester 2). Mark 9:23 Jesus said unto him, If thou canst believe, all things [are] possible to him that believeth. **Note**: Your part is to receive the perfection by believing the Bible and living it. **Do your best; God will do the rest.** Gal 2:20 You live but not you, Christ lives in you. Let Christ live in you. John 3:3 Your spirit was perfected when you were born again.
    - Eph 3:17 Let Christ dwell in your heart with only love and the WOG.
    - Ps 23:3 Restore your soul by living a godly cycle of change (HS Sem. 2).
    - 1 Cor 2:16 Protect your mind, for you have the mind of Christ.
    - Rom 12:2 Be transformed by the renewing of your mind that you may prove the good, acceptable and **perfect** will of God.
    - Rom 12:1 Present your <u>body</u> as a living sacrifice. You are the body of Christ.

Eph 4:30 Let your <u>words</u> not grieve the HS Who seals you unto redemption. Rom 6:13,16 You accomplish all these goals in your being by serving righteousness and not sin; and, thereby, you work the righteousness in your spirit out into your members as holiness.
