

## **Psalm 82:6**

Foundation Scripture:

Psa 82:6 I have said, Ye [are] **gods**; and all of you [are] **children of the most High.** 

- A. Jesus Said.
  - 1. Joh 10:34 Jesus answered them, Is it not written in your law, I said, Ye are gods?

Joh 10:35 If he called them gods, unto whom the word of God came, and the scripture cannot be broken;

Joh 10:36 Say ye of him, whom the Father hath sanctified, and sent into the world, Thou blasphemest; because I said, I am the Son of God?

- 2. Joh 10:30 I and [my] Father are one.
- 3. Joh 17:23 I in them, and thou in me, that they may be <u>made perfect</u> in one; and that the world may know that thou hast sent me, and hast loved them, as thou hast loved me.
- 4. Eph 3:19 And to know the love of Christ, which passeth knowledge, that ye might be filled with all the fulness of God.

## B. Old Covenant.

1. Moses.

Exo 7:1 And the LORD said unto Moses, See, I have made thee a god to Pharaoh: and Aaron thy brother shall be thy prophet.

2. Adam.

Gen 2:17 But of the tree of the knowledge of good and evil, thou shalt not eat of it: for in the day that thou eatest thereof <u>thou shalt surely die</u>. Gen 3:7 And the eyes of them both were opened, and they knew that they [were] naked; and they sewed fig leaves together, and made themselves aprons.

Luk 3:38 Which was [the son] of Enos, which was [the son] of Seth, which was [the son] of Adam, which was [the son] of God.

3. Elijah.

2Ki 2:11 And it came to pass, as they still went on, and talked, that, behold, [there appeared] a chariot of fire, and horses of fire, and parted them both asunder; and **Elijah went up by a whirlwind into heaven**.

4. All Believers.

Gen 1:26 And God said, Let us make man in our image, after our likeness: and let them have dominion over the fish of the sea, and over the fowl of the air, and over the cattle, and over all the earth, and over every creeping thing that creepeth upon the earth.

Gen 1:28 And God blessed them, and God said unto them, Be fruitful, and multiply, and replenish the earth, and <u>subdue it: and have dominion</u> over the fish of the sea, and over the fowl of the air, and over every living thing that moveth upon the earth.



**Gen 6:1** And it came to pass, when men [*i.e., those disobedient to God's ways (e.g., Cain and others like him Gen 5:4)*] began to multiply on the face of the earth, and daughters were born unto them,

Gen 6:2 That the **sons of God** (*i.e., those obedient to God's ways - Gen 5:3 Adam begat Seth in his own image and likeness*) saw the daughters of men that they [were] fair; and they took them wives of all which they chose.

**Job 1:6** Now there was a day when the **sons of God** came to present themselves before the LORD (*i.e., a worship service*), and Satan came also among them.

## C. New Covenant.

1. Satan's Fall and Current Position.

Adam sinned; and satan became god of this world but Jesus defeated him and made you a king and priest, a god over this world and over satan. Luk 4:5 And the devil, taking him up into an high mountain, shewed unto him all the kingdoms of the world in a moment of time.

Luk 4:6 The devil said unto him, All this power will I give thee & the glory of them: for that is delivered unto me; and to whomsoever I will I give it.

Luk 4:7 If thou therefore wilt worship me, all shall be thine.

**2Co 4:3** But if our gospel be hid, it is hid to them that are lost:

2Co 4:4 In whom the god of this world (satan) hath blinded the minds ....

**Eph 1:20** The Father has set [Jesus] at his own right hand in the heavenly [places], v21 Far above all principality, and power, and might, and dominion, and every name that is named, not only in this world, but also in that which is to come: v22 And hath put all [things] under his feet, Eph 2:6 And hath raised [us] up together, and made [us] sit together in heavenly [places] in Christ Jesus:

**Note:** Therefore, satan (the ex-god of this world) is way, way below you. He is under your feet. What does that make you?

2. Philip's Translation.

Act 8:39 And when they were come up out of the water, <u>the Spirit of the</u> <u>Lord caught away Philip</u>, that the eunuch saw him no more: and he went on his way rejoicing.

Act 8:40 But Philip was found at Azotus: and passing through he preached in all the cities, till he came to Caesarea.

3. Peter's Power in the Name of Jesus.

Act 3:6 Then Peter said, Silver and gold have I none; but such as I have give I thee: In the name of Jesus Christ of Nazareth rise up and walk.

Act 3:7 And he took him by the right hand, and lifted [him] up: and immediately his feet and ankle bones received strength.

Act 3:8 And he leaping up stood, and walked, and entered with them into the temple, walking, and leaping, and praising God.



4. Paul's divinity in Christ Jesus.

Act 28:4 When the barbarians saw the [venomous] beast hang on his hand, they said among themselves, No doubt this man is a murderer, though he hath escaped the sea, yet vengeance suffereth not to live. Act 28:5 And he shook off the beast into the fire, and felt no harm. Act 28:6 Howbeit they looked when he should have swollen, or fallen down dead suddenly: but after they had looked a great while, and saw no harm come to him, they changed their minds, **and said that he was a god.** 

- D. All Believers.
  - 1. Can You Believe It?

Mar 11:23 For verily I say unto you, That whosoever shall say unto this mountain, Be thou removed, and be thou cast into the sea; and <u>shall not</u> <u>doubt in his heart</u>, but shall believe that those things which he saith shall come to pass; he shall have whatsoever he saith.

Mar 9:23 Jesus said unto him, <u>If thou canst believe</u>, all things [are] possible to him that believeth.

Joh 11:26 And whosoever liveth and believeth in me **shall never die**. <u>Believest thou this</u>?

2. Partaking of His Divine Nature.

2Pe 1:4 Whereby are given unto us exceeding great and precious promises: that by these **ye might be partakers of the divine nature**, having escaped the corruption that is in the world through lust. Joh 14:12 Verily, verily, I say unto you, He that believeth on me, the works that I do shall he do also; and **greater [works] than these shall he do**; because I go unto my Father.

3. Filled with His Glory as a Part of the Perfect Church.

Eph 5:26 That he might sanctify and cleanse it with the washing of water by the word,

Eph 5:27 That he might present it to himself a glorious church, not having spot, or wrinkle, or any such thing; but that **it should be holy and without blemish.** 

4. The Power of the Glorious Church.

Rev 11:5 And if any man will hurt them, <u>fire proceedeth out of their</u> <u>mouth</u>, and devoureth their enemies: and if any man will hurt them, he must in this manner be killed.
