

Psalm 82:6-7

Foundation Scripture:

Psa 82:6 I have said, Ye [are] gods; and all of you [are] children of the most High.

Psa 82:7 But ye shall die like men, and fall like one of the princes.

Psa 82:8 Arise, O God, judge the earth: for thou shalt inherit all nations.

- A. Living or dying under the Old Testament.
 - 1. Deu 30:19 I call heaven and earth to record this day against you, [that] I have set before you life and death, blessing and cursing: therefore **choose life**, that both thou and thy seed may live:
 - 2. Gen 2:17 But of the tree of the knowledge of good and evil, thou shalt not eat of it: for in the day that thou eatest thereof thou shalt surely die.
 - 3. Deu 28:1 If thou shalt hearken diligently unto the voice of the LORD thy God, to observe [and] to do all his commandments

Deu 28:2 *then* all these blessings shall come on thee, and overtake thee, if thou shalt hearken unto the voice of the LORD thy God.

Deu 28:15 But if thou wilt not hearken unto the voice of the LORD thy God, to observe to do all his commandments and his statutes; that all these curses shall come upon thee, and overtake thee:

- B. Living or Dying under the New Testament.
 - 1. Sin leads to death.

Rom 6:23 For the wages of sin [is] death; but the gift of God [is] eternal life through Jesus Christ our Lord.

2. Living carnally is death.

Rom 8:6 For to be carnally minded [is] death; but to be spiritually minded [is] life and peace.

Rom 8:13 For if ye live after the flesh, ye shall die: but if ye through the Spirit do mortify the deeds of the body, ye shall live.

- 3. Our Savior Jesus redeemed us from sins and from death. (John 11:26)
- C. Live as Gods or Die Like Men.
 - 1. Can it be done?

Enoch and Elijah did it.

Abraham and Moses almost did it.

The 144,000 will do it (Rev 7 & 14).

Those who are alive and remain true to the Gospel will do it (1 Cor 15:51).

- 2. Live in Christ under the lordship of Jesus.
 - a) Die to self (pride) and sin.
 - b) Live without sinning [and, if you sin, confess it (1John 1:9)].
 - c) Live in the spirit, not carnally.
 - d) Let Christ, let love fill your heart.
- 3. If you choose to die, die in Christ for the dead in Christ will rise first at the return of Jesus (i.e., live with Jesus as Lord, not just as Savior).
