

Living in Authority

Foundation Scripture:

Psa 82:6 I have said, Ye [are] gods; and all of you [are] children of the most High. v7 But ye shall die like men.

A. Our Purpose Is to Live in Authority.

1. 1 Cor 15:51 Live and not die (Ps 116:17) by remaining true to the Gospel).
2. 2 Cor 5:20 Live as ambassadors of Heaven to be members of the standing army of Jesus, left on earth to keep the peace.
3. Eph 5:27 Live as a part of the Glorious Church.
4. Rom 8:13 Live to help prepare the way for the return of Jesus Messiah.
5. 1 Cor 15:26 Live to overcome the last enemy, death (2 Tim 1:10 abolished).

B. We are Equipped for Living in Authority.

1. Rom 8:17 We are joint heirs with Jesus.
2. Heb 10:14 We have been perfected and sanctified.
3. 1 Cor 2:16 We have the mind of Christ.
4. Phil 2:9-10 We have power in three worlds through the Name of Jesus.
5. Eph 6:12-18 We have the armor of God, including the Sword of the Spirit.

C. We Prepare to Unleash our Authority by Living as Gods.

God:	Our Characteristics in Christ Jesus:
Cannot sin	Rom 6:11 We reckon ourselves dead to sin.
Cannot fail	Rom 8:37 We are more than super-conquerors.
Lives in faith	Rom 14:23 Anything that is not of faith is a sin.
Is patient	Heb 6:12 With faith & patience you get the answer.
Is humble (Phil 2:8)	Jam 4:6 God gives grace to the humble.
Is gentle (Holy Spirit)	2Tim 2:24, 25 Be gentle unto all; in meekness, teach.

D. Living in Dominion.

1. Overview.

You live in dominion when you walk continually in authority over all the kingdoms of this world.

You are a joint-heir with Jesus. Everything has already been given to you, so you do not ask God for anything nor ask Him to do anything in the earth; rather you command what you desire into existence.

2. Old Covenant.

Isa 45:11 Thus saith the LORD, the Holy One of Israel, and his Maker, Ask me of things to come concerning my sons, and concerning the work of my hands command ye me.

Jos 10:12 Then spake Joshua to the LORD and he said in the sight of Israel, Sun, stand thou still upon Gibeon; and thou, Moon, in Ajalon.

3. New Covenant.

Mat 17:20 And Jesus said unto them, If ye have faith as a grain of mustard seed, ye shall say unto this mountain, Remove hence to yonder place; and it shall remove; and nothing shall be impossible unto you.

Mat 21:21 Jesus answered and said unto them, Verily I say unto you, If ye have faith, and doubt not, ye shall not only do this [which is done] to the fig tree, but also if ye shall say unto this mountain, Be thou removed, and be thou cast into the sea; it shall be done.

4. Greater works.

Joh 14:12 Verily, verily, I say unto you, He that believeth on me, the works that I do shall he do also; and greater [works] than these shall he do; because I go unto my Father.

Mat 28:18 And Jesus came and spake unto them, saying, All power is given unto me in heaven and in earth. Mat 28:19 Go ye therefore,

Note: Jesus ministered as Son of Man (85 times) under Gen 1:26 & 28.

Now we are to minister with power over both the earth and the heavenlies; actually, in the Name of Jesus, we have power in 3 worlds.

You do it.

Mar 16:17 And these signs shall follow them that believe; In my name shall they cast out devils; they shall speak with new tongues;

Mar 16:18 They shall take up serpents; if they drink any deadly thing, it shall not hurt them; they shall lay hands on the sick, & they shall recover.

Mar 16:20 And they went forth, and preached every where, the Lord working with [them], and confirming the word with signs following. Amen.

Mat 10:8 Heal the sick, cleanse the lepers, raise the dead, cast out devils: freely ye have received, freely give.

Command it with your authority.

Joh 14:13 And whatsoever ye shall ask (G154) in my name, that will I do, that the Father may be glorified in the Son. (G154, demand for item due.)

Joh 14:14 If ye shall ask (*demand G154*) any thing in my name, I will do [it] (*and if I do not have it, I will make it for you*). Review Strong's G4441.

5. Protection.

Luk 10:19 Behold, I give unto you power to tread on serpents and scorpions, and over all the power of the enemy: and nothing shall by any means hurt you.

Psa 91:9 Because thou hast made the LORD, [which is] my refuge, [even] the most High, thy habitation;

Psa 91:10 There shall no evil befall thee, neither shall any plague come nigh thy dwelling.
