

Introduction to Glorified Bodies

Overview: Sin is transgression of the Law.

1Jo 3:4 Whosoever committeth sin transgresseth also the law: for sin is the transgression of the law.

1Jo 3:9 Whosoever is born of God doth not commit sin; for his seed remaineth in him: and he cannot sin, because he is born of God.

A. Types of Glorified Bodies (GB).

1. GB subject to change, sin or death.
 - a. Adam sinned and died, spiritually then physically.
 - b. Jesus in His ministry. He had to accept sin and lay down His life so that they could take His life.
 - c. Members of the Glorious Church will stop sinning and will not die but they will change.
 - d. The 144,000 will not sin; at least, not after being born again; they will not die but be caught up as first fruits of the earth to be with Jesus.
2. GB not subject to change nor sin nor death.
 - a. Enoch and Elijah were given GB and taken to be with God.
 - b. Overcomers, those who are alive and remain, will have glorified bodies which will never change nor sin nor die.
 - c. The two witnesses, raised from the dead, ascended up into Heaven.
 - d. Jesus after His resurrection went to be with His Father and was given a glorified body which cannot change nor sin nor die.

B. Manifesting your Glorified Body.

1. God's Part.
 - a. Rom 8:29 For whom he did foreknow, he also did predestinate [to be] conformed to the image of his Son, that he might be the firstborn among many brethren. v30 Moreover whom he did predestinate, them he also called: and whom he called, them he also justified: and whom he justified, them he also glorified.
 - b. Heb 10:14 For by one offering he hath perfected for ever them that are sanctified.
 - c. 2Co 5:21 For he hath made him [to be] sin for us, who knew no sin; that we might be made the righteousness of God in him.
 - d. 1Jo 4:16 And we have known and believed the love that God hath to us. God is love; and he that dwelleth in love dwelleth in God, and God in him. 1Jo 4:17 Herein is our love made perfect, that we may have boldness in the day of judgment: because as he is, so are we in this world.

2. Your Part.

- a. Mark 11:24 As you believe, so shall you receive.
Mar 9:23 Jesus said unto him, If thou canst believe, all things [are] possible to him that believeth.
- b. Mat 12:37 For by thy words thou shalt be justified, and by thy words thou shalt be condemned.
- c. 1Pe 2:24 Who his own self bare our sins in his own body on the tree, that we, being dead to sins, should live unto righteousness: by whose stripes ye were healed.
- d. Rom 6:13 Neither yield ye your members [as] instruments of unrighteousness unto sin: but yield yourselves unto God, as those that are alive from the dead, and your members [as] instruments of righteousness unto God.
Rom 6:14 For sin shall not have dominion over you: for ye are not under the law, but under grace.
Rom 6:15 What then? shall we sin, because we are not under the law, but under grace? God forbid.
Rom 6:16 Know ye not, that to whom ye yield yourselves servants to obey, his servants ye are to whom ye obey; whether of sin unto death, or of obedience unto righteousness?
- e. Rom 6:22 But now being made free from sin, and become servants to God, ye have your fruit unto holiness, and the end everlasting life.
