

## Do Your Best God Will Do the Rest

Joh 14:6 Jesus saith unto him, I am the way, the truth, and the life: no man cometh unto the Father, but by me.

1Co 10:13 There hath no temptation taken you but such as is common to man: but God [is] faithful, who will not suffer you to be tempted above that ye are able; but will with the temptation also make a way to escape, that ye may be able to bear [it].

2Co 12:9 And he said unto me, My grace is sufficient for thee: for my strength is made perfect in weakness. Most gladly therefore will I rather glory in my infirmities, that the power of Christ may rest upon me.

2Co 12:10 Therefore I take pleasure in infirmities, in reproaches, in necessities, in persecutions, in distresses for Christ's sake: for when I am weak, then am I strong.

Mat 5:28 But I say unto you, That whosoever looketh on a woman to lust after her hath committed adultery with her already in his heart.

Gen 22:10 And Abraham stretched forth his hand, and took the knife to slay his son.

Rom 4:3 For what saith the scripture? Abraham believed God, and it was counted unto him for righteousness.

Gal 3:6 Even as Abraham believed God, and it was accounted to him for righteousness.

Jam 2:23 And the scripture was fulfilled which saith, Abraham believed God, and it was imputed unto him for righteousness: and he was called the Friend of God.

Mat 6:33 But seek ye first the kingdom of God, and his righteousness; and all these things shall be added unto you.

Rom 14:17 For the kingdom of God is not meat and drink; but righteousness, and peace, and joy in the Holy Ghost.

Jam 4:8 You do your best, one step at a time. Commit in your heart and take a step towards God; and continue taking a step towards God.



## Additional notes taught in the lesson.

## You are responsible for the Word you hear in your heart, not mind.

Mark 4 Satan comes immediately to steal the Word <u>out of your heart</u>; but for the most part, Satan ignores the Word in your mind. Satan does not care about you and your hearing the Word in your mind, especially if you ignore the Word, reject it or harden your heart against it; typically, I think, Satan ignores you and your hearing of the Word even if you give the Word just mental assent. In all these examples, you have heard the Word in your mind but not in your heart.

John 8:31-31 You grow from level to level by continuing in the Word. You hear and get the Word into your heart by believing it and taking an action on it; then temptation comes; the way out of the temptation is the Word in your heart. You fight through the temptation and you get a testimony; you are now at a higher level with a bigger devil. The process repeats. Satan comes again to tempt and steal Word out of heart; you again fight through the challenge with the Word being the way out; and you go to a higher level, bigger devil, etc., until you are set free. He who continues in the Word gets set free.
