B. The Relationship Names of God

(1) Lord Jehovah

- The Lord Jehovah is my strength and my salvation. Isa 12:2
- In the Name of Jesus, God has not appointed me to wrath, but to obtain salvation by our Lord Jesus Christ. 1 Th 5:9

(2) Jehovah-Jireh

- The Lord is my Provider. Gen 22:14
- God supplies all my need according to His riches in glory by Christ Jesus. Phil 4:19

(3) Jehovah-Rapha

- The Lord is my Healer. Ex 15:26
- I have been healed by the stripes of Jesus. 1 Pet 2:24

(4) Jehovah-Shalom

- The Lord is my Peace. Jdg 6:24
- In the Name of Jesus, the peace of God rules in my heart. Col 3:15

(5) Jehovah-Nissi

- The Lord is my Banner (Victory). Ex 17:15
- In the Name of Jesus, God is my strength, my personal bravery, and my invincible army (Amplified Bible Classic). Hab 3:19

(6) **Jehovah-Tsidkenu**

- The Lord is my Righteousness. Jer 23:6
- I am the righteousness of God in Christ Jesus. 2 Cor 5:21

(7) **Jehovah-Rohi**

- The Lord is my Shepherd. Psa 23:1
- In the Name of Jesus, the Lord has given me all things that pertain to life and godliness. 2 Pet 1:3

(8) **Jehovah-Shammah**

- The Lord is there (with me). Ezek 8:35
- In the Name of Jesus, the Lord is my helper and He will never leave me nor forsake me. Heb 13:5,6

(9) **Jehovah-Qadash**

- The Lord is my Sanctifier. Ex 31:13
- In the Name of Jesus, I reckon myself dead to sin but alive to God through Jesus Christ. Rom 6:11
