

One Sacrifice Part 2

Foundational Scripture:

Heb 9:13 For if the blood of bulls and of goats, and the ashes of an heifer sprinkling the unclean, sanctifieth to the purifying of the flesh:

Heb 9:14 How much more shall the blood of Christ, who through the eternal Spirit offered himself without spot to God, purge your conscience from dead works to serve the living God?

A. Day of Atonement.

Lev 16:3 Thus shall Aaron come into the holy [place]: with a young bullock for a sin offering, and a ram for a burnt offering.

Lev 16:5 And he shall take of the congregation of the children of Israel two kids of the goats for a sin offering, and one ram for a burnt offering.

Lev 16:17 have made an atonement for himself, and for his household, and for all the congregation of Israel.

1. Atonement for Aaron.

Lev 16:6 And Aaron shall offer his bullock of the sin offering, which [is] for himself, and make an atonement for himself, and for his house.

Lev 16:14 And he shall take of the blood of the bullock, and sprinkle [it] with his finger upon the mercy seat eastward; and before the mercy seat shall he sprinkle of the blood with his finger seven times.

2. Atonement for the Congregation

Lev 16:15 Then shall he kill the goat of the sin offering, that [is] for the people, and bring his blood within the vail, and do with that blood as he did with the blood of the bullock, and sprinkle it upon the mercy seat, and before the mercy seat:

3. Scapegoat.

Lev 16:20 And when he hath made an end of reconciling the holy [place], and the tabernacle of the congregation, and the altar, he shall bring the live goat:

Lev 16:21 And Aaron shall lay both his hands upon the head of the live goat, and confess over him all the iniquities of the children of Israel, and all their transgressions in all their sins, putting them upon the head of the goat, and shall send [him] away by the hand of a fit man into the wilderness:

Lev 16:22 And the goat shall bear upon him all their iniquities unto a land not inhabited: and he shall let go the goat in the wilderness.

4. Burnt Offering.

Lev 16:24 Aaron shall offer his burnt offering, and the burnt offering of the people, and make an atonement for himself, and for the people.

5. The Remains of the Sin Offering.

Lev 16:27 One shall carry the remains without the camp and burn them.

B. Crucifixion of the Lamb of God.

Events are listed in the order of the Day of Atonement

Day of Atonement	Purpose of the Sacrifice	Day of Crucifixion	Purpose of the Sacrifice
Sin Offering			
Kill bullock	The bullock was killed to pay for the wages of sin for the past year so they could enter the new year without sin.	Kill Jesus. He died for our sins so we do not have to die.	Paid the wages of sin for mankind. This resulted in the dead coming out of opened graves.
Sprinkle blood	The blood is put on the Mercy Seat to atone for the people, and sprinkled as an atonement to reconcile the Holy Place, the Tabernacle of the Congregation and the Sacrificial altar.	The Seven Sheddings of the Blood of Jesus.	Sprinkled the world with His Blood to reconcile it back to God, resulting in the vail in the temple being torn & graves opened and an earthquake when He died.
Scapegoat	Bear the iniquities of the past year so that the nation can be free of their bruising for the coming year.	He was bruised for our iniquities.	He bore iniquities so we could be healed. Luke 4:18 set at liberty those that are bruised.
Burnt Offering	"Perfect" ram is burnt as an atonement for them.	Perfect "Lamb of God" is burnt in hell.	He went to hell so we do not have to go.
Sin Offering		Sin Offering	
Remains are burnt outside the camp.	Penalty of sin is separation from holiness plus burning.	Sins in His Body separated Him from God to die.	Went to hell for us and burnt for our sins.
		Resurrection after crucifixion He rose from the dead but was still unclean and could not be touched.	He poured His Blood on the mercy seat, remitting the sins of mankind and starting the Age of Grace.
