

Petition Prayer

Overview:

John 16:23 .. Whatsoever ye shall ask the Father in my name, he will give [it] you. Jam 5:15 And the prayer of faith shall save the sick, and the Lord shall raise him up; and if he have committed sins, they shall be forgiven him.

A. Prayer of Faith Review.

The Prayer of Faith (POF) in Mark 11:24, states, "What things soever you desire, when you pray, believe that you receive them and you shall have them." This says that you shall have "them" when "them" meets the following three conditions:

- 1. You must desire them.
- 2. You must pray for them.
- 3. You must believe that you receive them at the time when you pray.

B. Confessing Sins.

God is Holy. Before praying, we recommend that you confess your sins. 1Jo 1:9 If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just to forgive us [our] sins, and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.

C. What is Petition Prayer?

Petition Prayer is asking God for something typically for yourself.

1Jo 5:14 And this is the confidence that we have in him, that, if we ask any thing according to his will, he heareth us.

1Jo 5:15 And if we know that he hear us, whatsoever we ask, we know that we have the petitions that we desired of him.

D. Steps in Petition Prayer.

Preface: As with everything you do before approaching a Holy God, confess your sins (1Jo 1:9).

Pray to your Father in Heaven.
Pray in the Name of Jesus.
Pray aloud.
Ask once.
Believe that you receive when you ask.

6. Act as if you believe that you received (i.e., use actions and words which reflect that you believe you received when you prayed).

Keep thanking God with affirmations until there is a manifestation.

In every thing give thanks: for this is the will 1Th 5:18 of God in Christ Jesus concerning you

7. After the manifestation, tell someone, what God Rev 12:11 has done for you.
