

## Introduction to the Fullness of Redemption

### A. Review.

#### 1. The Fundamentals.

Rom 3:23 All have sinned and come short of the glory of God.

1 Pet 2:24a Jesus bore your sins in His body on the tree that you, being dead to sin, should live unto righteousness.

Rom 6:23 You have eternal life because Jesus *took the wages of your sins*.

#### 2. Your rights in Jesus.

1 Pet 2:24b I have been healed by the stripes of Jesus.

2 Pet 1:3 According as his divine power hath given unto us all things that [pertain] unto life and godliness ....

Joh 14:13 And whatsoever ye shall ask in my name, that will I do ....

Act 2:21 .... whosoever shall call on the name of the Lord shall be saved.

### B. Redemption in Jesus.

#### 1. Living in Jesus Christ.

His Name is Jesus. His title is Christ, the Messiah. Christ means the anointed One and His anointing. As the Man-Christ, Jesus lived as a perfect man to die for us. We are born again by accepting Jesus as Savior. We are in Jesus (Christ) when we are living with **Jesus as our Savior**.

#### 2. But there is more.

In Jesus Christ we inherit our Salvation Package and are able to access some of our divine inheritance. We are born again into the Family of God, so a Christian will go to Heaven if s/he dies during the Age of Grace. We are to preach, teach, heal and work miracles in the Name of Jesus (Christ).

### C. Redemption in Christ.

#### 1. Living in Christ Jesus.

As the Christ-Man, Jesus rose from the dead into the Resurrection Power of a new life with a glorified body. All power in heaven and earth now belongs to Him and He has given us the legal right to use His Name, Jesus, in which is vested all authority over everything in 3 worlds (Phil 2:10).

#### 2. Benefits.

While Jesus is in Heaven, the Body of Christ has been made ambassadors to represent Him (2 Cor 5:20). We operate in this role, as we choose to be in Christ Jesus which means living with **Jesus as our Lord**. This gives us full access to all the awesome promises in the New Testament.

Phi 4:7 The peace of God keeps your hearts, minds through Christ Jesus.

Phil 4:19 My God supplies all my need .... by Christ Jesus.

Rom 8:1 [There is] no condemnation to them which are in Christ Jesus ....

Eph 2:6 And hath raised [us] up together, and made [us] sit together in heavenly [places] in Christ Jesus:
