A. Definitions

 - d. Not having to work.
- 2. Webster defines prosperity to be:
 - a. The condition of being successful or thriving.
 - b. Economic well-being.
- 3. Webster defines "to prosper" as:
 - a. To succeed in an enterprise or activity.
 - b. To achieve economic success.
 - c. To become strong and flourishing.

B. God's Definition

- 1. Prosper Internally (i.e., in self). (Strong's 7919 Saw-kal).
 - a. Prosper in all you do.

Deut 29:9

b. Prosper wherever you go.

Joshua 1:7

- c. Meanings: To be intelligent, expert, skillful, prudent; to be successful; to understand, to be wise.
- 2. Prosper Externally in possessions & actions. (Strong's 6743 Tsaw-lakh).
 - a. Whatsoever you do shall prosper.

Ps 1:3

b. The Lord makes it to prosper.

Gen 39:23

- c. Meanings: Break out, come mightily, go over, be good, be profitable, be prosperous.
- 3. Prosper Internally and Externally. (Strong's 2137– Yoo-od-o-o).
 - a. Prosperous journey.

Rom 1:10

b. As God has prospered him.

1 Cor 16:2

- c. Prosper and be in health even as your soul prospers. 3 John 2
- d. Meanings: succeed in reaching, succeed in business, have a prosperous journey.



C. Prosperity in Life

1. Make your election sure.

2 Peter 1:10

2Pe 1:2 Grace and peace be multiplied unto you through the knowledge of God, and of Jesus our Lord,

2Pe 1:3 According as his divine power hath given unto us all things that [pertain] unto life and godliness, through the knowledge of him that hath called us to glory and virtue:

2Pe 1:4 Whereby are given unto us exceeding great and precious promises: that by these ye might be partakers of the divine nature, having escaped the corruption that is in the world through lust.

2Pe 1:8 For if these things be in you, and abound, they make [you that ye shall] neither [be] barren nor unfruitful in the knowledge of our Lord Jesus Christ.

2Pe 1:9 But he that lacketh these things is blind, and cannot see afar off, and hath forgotten that he was purged from his old sins.

2Pe 1:10 Wherefore the rather, brethren, give diligence to make your calling and election sure: for if ye do these things, ye shall never fall:

 - 1Jo 5:4 For whatsoever is born of God overcometh the world: and this is the victory that overcometh the world, [even] our faith.

 1Jo 5:16 If any man see his brother sin a sin [which is] not unto death, he shall ask, and he shall give him life for them that sin not unto death. There is a sin unto death: I do not say that he shall pray for it.
 - 1Jo 5:17 All unrighteousness is sin: and there is a sin not unto death.
 - 1Jo 5:18 We know that whosoever is born of God sinneth not; but he that is begotten of God keepeth himself, and that wicked one toucheth him not.
