

Fullness of Redemption

Overview.

Matt 11:11 states that Jesus said, "Among them that are born of women there hath not risen a greater than John the Baptist: notwithstanding he that is least in the kingdom of heaven is greater than he."

Foundational Scripture.

1Co 1:30 But of him are ye in Christ Jesus, who of God is made unto us wisdom, and righteousness, and sanctification, and redemption:

Because of His love for you, God has made Jesus to take all your sins and iniquities and the wages of them so that Jesus could purchase for you every blessing and everything you need for life and godliness (2 Pet 1:3) and to be an overcomer over every challenge of life (1 John 5:4,5).

Levels of Salvation.

John 16:7-15 As you respond to the leading of the Holy Spirit to partner with God in living the Word, you move from feeding on milk to meat to strong meat. This journey takes you from living with Jesus as your wisdom, as your righteousness, as your sanctification and eventually to living with Jesus as your redemption. 2Co 5:17 Therefore if any man [be] in Christ, [he is] a new creature: old things are passed away; behold, all things are become new.

A. Jesus Is our Wisdom.

Jesus is the way, the truth and the life. His sacrifice provided the way for you to get the wisdom to know that you were a sinner needing a savior in order to obtain eternal life through the salvation of being born again into the family of God.

- 1. Psa 111:10 The fear of the LORD [is] the beginning of wisdom:
- 2. Pro 1:7 The fear of the LORD [is] the beginning of knowledge: [but] fools despise wisdom and instruction.
 - Pro 9:10 The fear of the LORD [is] the beginning of wisdom: and the knowledge of the holy [is] understanding.
- 3. Pro 11:30 and he that winneth souls [is] wise.
- 4. Eph 1:17 That the God of our Lord Jesus Christ, the Father of glory, may give unto you the spirit of wisdom and revelation in the knowledge of him:



B. Jesus Is our Righteousness.

- 1. 2Co 5:21 For he hath made him [to be] sin for us, who knew no sin; that we might be made the righteousness of God in him.
- 2. Rom 8:1 [There is] therefore now no condemnation to them which are in Christ Jesus, who walk not after the flesh, but after the Spirit.
- 3. Rom 8:32 He that spared not his own Son, but delivered him up for us all, how shall he not with him also freely give us all things?
- 4. Rom 6:10 For in that he died, he died unto sin once: but in that he liveth, he liveth unto God.
 - Rom 6:11 Likewise reckon ye also yourselves to be dead indeed unto sin, but alive unto God through Jesus Christ our Lord.

C. Jesus Is our Sanctification.

- 1. 1Co 6:19 What? know ye not that your body is the temple of the Holy Ghost [which is] in you, which ye have of God, and ye are not your own?
 1Co 6:20 For ye are bought with a price: therefore glorify God in your body, and in your spirit, which are God's.
 - 1Pe 1:2 through sanctification of the Spirit, unto obedience and sprinkling of the blood of Jesus Christ
- 2. Rom 6:13 Neither yield ye your members [as] instruments of unrighteousness unto sin: but yield yourselves unto God, Rom 6:16 Know ye not, that to whom ye yield yourselves servants to obey, his servants ye are to whom ye obey; whether of sin unto death, or of obedience unto righteousness? v19 even so now yield your members servants to righteousness unto holiness.
- 3. Eph 5:25 Christ also loved the church, and gave himself for it; v26 That he might sanctify and cleanse it with the washing of water by the word, v27 That he might present it to himself a glorious church, not having spot, or wrinkle, or any such thing; but that it should be holy and without blemish.
- 4. 1Jo 1:9 If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just to forgive us [our] sins, and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.

D. Jesus Is our Redemption.

- 1. Living in Christ Jesus.
 - Rom 8:29 For whom he did foreknow, he also did predestinate [to be] conformed to the image of his Son, that he might be the firstborn among many brethren. v30 Moreover whom he did predestinate, them he also called: and whom he called, them he also justified: and whom he justified, them he also glorified.
- 2. Rom 8:17 if children, then heirs; heirs of God, and joint-heirs with Christ;
- 3. Eph 4:30 And grieve not the holy Spirit of God, whereby ye are sealed unto the day of redemption.
- 4. Rev 21:7 He that overcometh shall inherit all things; and I will be his God, and he shall be my son.
