

## Preparing for the Return of Jesus Part 4 – Be Led by the Spirit of God

Overview: Being led by the Spirit of God is the most important thing you can do for success, for health, for life, for being alive and remaining to be raptured, and for becoming an overcomer in the ages to come.

### A. Review.

1. Summary: Jesus is your example. What would Jesus do (WWJD)?
2. Part 1 - Flee unforgiveness.
3. Part 2 - Stay in your Seal of Protection. Quit murmuring.
4. Part 3 – Live as kings and priests. Give assignments to angels.

### B. OWAL. Refer to on-demand video 11-21-2021

1. **O**ccupy till He comes (Luke 18:13).
2. **W**ork as unto the Lord (Col 3:23).
3. **A**nointing – stay under the Anointing (Stay in the KOG).
4. **L**ove God and love your neighbor as yourself.

### C. Led by the Spirit of God.

1. Live the Word of God (WOG).  
To be led by the Spirit, you must live the Word. Be washed by the Word.
2. Jesus was led by His Father. He did only what the Father did (John 5:19) and said only what the Father said (John 8:28).  
Jesus said that, when you see Him, you see the Father (John 14:9). Who do men see when they see you? As Jesus was in unity with His Father, so we should be in unity with the Holy Spirit of God.
3. Being led by the Spirit is synonymous with walking in the Spirit.  
Rom 8:1 [There is] therefore now no condemnation to them which are in Christ Jesus, who walk not after the flesh, but after the Spirit.

Being led by the Spirit is also synonymous with walking in Christ Jesus (i.e., living with Jesus as Lord requires obedience to the WOG and being led by the Spirit in all decisions not directly discernible from the Word).  
Col 2:6 As ye have therefore received Christ Jesus the Lord, [so] walk ye in him:

In a similar manner, for areas beyond the details of the Word, being led by the Spirit is also synonymous with living in the Spirit (Gal 5:25), with seeking after the Spirit, with minding the things of the Spirit, with being spiritually minded, with being in the Spirit, etc.

Being led by the Spirit is also synonymous with walking by faith and living in faith.

Gal 3:3 Are ye so foolish? having begun in the Spirit, are ye now made perfect by the flesh?

4. To be led by the Spirit is life.

Gal 5:16 [This] I say then, Walk in the Spirit, and ye shall not fulfill the lust of the flesh.

Gal 5:17 For the flesh lusteth against the Spirit, and the Spirit against the flesh: and these are contrary the one to the other: so that ye cannot do the things that ye would.

Gal 5:18 But if ye be led of the Spirit, ye are not under the law.

Rom 6:23 For (*under law*), the wages of sin [is] death; but the gift of God [is] eternal life through Jesus Christ our Lord.

Rom 8:1 [There is] therefore now no condemnation to them which are in Christ Jesus, who walk not after the flesh, but (*who walk*) after the Spirit.

Rom 8:2 For the law of the Spirit of life in Christ Jesus hath made me free from the law of sin and death.

Rom 8:11 But if the Spirit of him that raised up Jesus from the dead dwell in you, he that raised up Christ from the dead shall also quicken (*i.e., give life to*) your mortal bodies by his Spirit that dwelleth in you.

Rom 8:12 Therefore, brethren, we are debtors, not to the flesh, to live after the flesh.

Rom 8:13 For if ye live after the flesh, ye shall die: but if ye through the Spirit do mortify the deeds of the body, ye shall live.

Rom 8:14 For as many as are led by the Spirit of God, they are the sons of God (*the overcomers {Rev 21:7}*).

Rom 8:5 For they that are after the flesh do mind the things of the flesh; but they that are after the Spirit the things of the Spirit.

Rom 8:6 For to be carnally minded [is] death; but to be spiritually minded [is] life and peace.
