

You Can Overcome the Spirit of Fear

A. When Faced with a Challenge, a Christian Should Operate in Faith not in Fear by:

1. Learning an acronym.
 - a. Being in F.A.I.T.H. Heb 11:1 (AMPC)
(Factual Authentication Indisputably Truthful in Heaven)
 - b. Being in F.E.A.R. John 8:44; 1 John 2:21
(False Evidence Appearing Real)
2. Believing in what will come to pass.
 - a. Being in faith is believing in God's promises. Mark 11:24; Heb 11:6
 - b. Being in fear is believing in the devil's deceptions. Gen 3:1-5; 2 Cor 11:3; Rev 12:9
3. Accepting a report.
 - a. Being in faith is accepting God's good report of the Lord. Num 13:1-2; Num 13:30; Num 14:1-45; Josh 2:9-11
 - b. Being in fear is accepting bad/evil reports and assumptions. Num 13:32-33; Num 14:1-45; Zeph 3:13
4. Obeying the loudest voice.
 - a. Being in faith is obeying the voice of the Holy Spirit in thoughts. Rom 10:17; Matt 17:20; Luke 18:8b; John 16:13
 - b. Being in fear is obeying the voice of demonic thoughts which convince the person to be deceived by F.E.A.R., including assumptions and intimidation. Jam 1:13-15; 2 Cor 10:4-5
5. Yielding to the one given the most influence.
 - a. Being in faith is yielding to the Holy Spirit's influence. Rom 15:13 (AMPC); Gal 3:13-14
 - b. Being in fear is yielding to influence of The Snake, shame, Gen 2:16-27; Gen 3:1-19
intimidation, trauma, dread, anxiety, stress, worry, pandemics, mental health, and others.
6. Partnering with power.
 - a. Being in faith is partnering with God's power. Luke 10:19; Acts 28:3-5
 - b. Being in fear is partnering with the devil's power. 2 Tim 2:26; 1 Tim 4:1

B. You Can Overcome Fear.

1. Confess all sins, especially when in fear. Ps 34:4; 2 Tim 1:6-7
1 John 1:9
2. Repent, Renounce, Break (RRB) and Cleanse. Luke 17:3; Titus 2:12; Gal 3:13; Rom 8:2
3. **Walk in love – perfect love casts out fear.** 1 John 4:18; 4:20-21
4. Affirm scriptures to overcome fear.
 - a. 2 Time 1:7 (NKJV & AMPC) In the Name of Jesus, God has not given me the spirit of fear, but of the Dunamis Miraculous Resurrection Power, and of love and a calm, well-balanced, disciplined, self-controlled, sound mind.
 - b. 1 John 4:18 In the Name of Jesus, God's perfect love in me casts out all fear and torment.
 - c. Romans 8:15 In the Name of Jesus, God has not given me a spirit of bondage again to fear; but I have received the Spirit of adoption by whom I cry Abba, Father.
 - d. Joshua 1:9 In the Name of Jesus, God has caused me to be strong, of good courage, not afraid, nor dismayed and God is with me wherever I go.
