A. What Is an Ambassador?

- 1. Ambassadorship---Webster's New World Dictionary (1957): the rank, duties, office, or term of office of an ambassador.
- 2. Ambassador---Webster:
 - a. The highest-ranking representative appointed by one country or government to represent it in another.
 - b. A special representative.
 - c. An official herald, messenger, or agent with a special mission.
- 3. Ambassador---Wikipedia: an ambassador is an official envoy, especially a high-ranking diplomat who represents a state.

B. Duties and Responsibilities of an Ambassador

- 1. Oppenheim (in his book): "diplomats are the mouthpiece of the head of his own State and the Foreign Minister for communication to be made to the State where they are dispatched."
- 2. Wikipedia: Ambassador helps to promote peace, trade, and the exchange of information between home country and foreign lands.

C. Rights and Privileges of an Ambassador

- 1. Special residences, considered property of home country.
- 2. Full immunity from prosecution.
