A. Prayer and God's Word Changed Their Circumstances.

1. Daniel was promoted, vindicated, and saved. Dan 2 and 6
2. Shadrach, Meshach, and Abednego were saved. Dan 3
3. Mordecai was honored because he saved the king. Esth 6:11
4. Esther was used by God to save her people. Esth 4:14-16
5. Joseph stayed faithful to God and saved his people. Gen 45

B. Prayer and God's Word Can Change Your Current Circumstances.

1. Ps 37:19 They shall not be ashamed in the evil time, and in the days of famine they shall be satisfied.
2. Eph 6:18 Praying always with all prayer and supplication in the Spirit, being watchful to this end with all perseverance and supplication for all the saints.
3. Rom 8:26-27 Likewise the Spirit also helps in our weaknesses. For we do not know what we should pray for as we ought, but the Spirit Himself makes intercession for us with groanings which cannot be uttered. The Spirit intercedes for God's people in accordance with the will of God.
4. 1 Cor 14:15-16 I will pray with the spirit, and I will also pray with the understanding.
5. Phil 4:6 Be anxious for nothing, but in everything by prayer and supplication, with thanksgiving, let your requests be made known to God.
6. Matt 17:20 If you have faith as a mustard seed, you will say to this mountain, Move from here to there, and it will move; and nothing will be impossible for you.
7. John 15:7 If you abide in Me, and My words abide in you, you will ask what you desire, and it shall be done for you.
8. Pray for one another, that you may be healed. The effective, fervent prayer of a righteous man avails much.
9. Ps 133:1, 3 Behold, how good and how pleasant it is for brethren to dwell together in unity! For there the Lord commanded the blessing.
10. Gen 11:6 (AMPC) And the Lord said, Behold, they are one people and they have [all one language; and this is only the beginning of what they will do, and now nothing they have imagined they can do will be impossible for them.

11. Acts 1:14 These all continued with one accord in prayer and supplication.
12. 2 Cor 1:11 You also helping together in prayer for us, that thanks may be given by many persons on our behalf.
13. John 17: 15-16 I do not pray that You should take them out of the world, but that You should keep them from the evil one. They are not of the world, just as I am not of the world.
14. Rev 21:7 He who overcomes shall inherit all things, and I will be his God and he shall be My son.
15. Mark 14:37-38 Then He came and found them sleeping, and said to Peter, "Simon, are you sleeping? **Could you not watch one hour? Watch and pray**, lest you enter into temptation. The spirit indeed is willing, but the flesh is weak."
