

## How to Abide and Bond with God

# A. Abide and Bond with God by Not Being B.U.S.Y.

- 1. Being B.U.S.Y. is Being Under Satan's Yoke.
- 2. Distraction can cause Christians to be distanced from God.
  - a. James 4:4 Whoever therefore wants to be a friend of the world makes himself an enemy of God.
  - b. 1 John 2:15-17 <sup>15</sup> Do not love the world or the things in the world...
    - 16...the lust of the flesh, the lust of the eyes, and the pride of life...
    - <sup>17</sup>... but he who does the will of God **abides** forever.
- 3. Focus on abiding and bonding closer to God to overcome those challenges.
  - a. Isa 26:3 You will keep him in perfect peace, whose mind is stayed on You, because he trusts in You.
  - b. Col 3:2 Set your mind on things above, not on things on the earth.
  - c. Psa 1:1-3 <sup>1</sup> Blessed is the man who walks not in the counsel of the ungodly, nor stands in the path of sinners, nor sits in the seat of the scornful; <sup>2</sup> But his delight is in the law of the Lord, and in His law he meditates day and night. <sup>3</sup> He shall be like a tree planted by the rivers of water, that brings forth its fruit in its season, whose leaf also shall not wither; and whatever he does shall prosper.
- 4. Abide and bond successfully.
  - a. A bond with family, good friends, co-workers is an important part of your life.
  - b. A bond is achieved by spending quality time with the person(s).
  - c. A bond means that you have a reciprocal relationship.
  - d. A bond means you are assured that you can count on the person(s).
- 5. Abide and bond with God even closer than the bonds you have now.
  - a. Gal 4:5-6 <sup>5</sup> ...We might receive **the adoption as sons**. <sup>6</sup> And because you are sons, God has sent forth the Spirit of His Son into your hearts, crying out, "**Abba, Father!**"
  - b. 2 Cor 13:14 The grace of the Lord Jesus Christ, and the love of God, and the **communion** of the Holy Spirit be with you all. Amen.
  - c. Prov 18:24 ...But there is a friend who sticks closer than a brother (Jesus).
  - d. Heb 13:5 I will never leave you nor forsake you.

# B. Abide and Bond with God to Bring Powerful Rewards.

1. John 8:31-32 If you abide (bond) in God's Word, you are truly His disciples, and you will know the truth and the truth will set you free!



- 2. 1 John 3:24 Now he who keeps His commandments **abides (bonds) in Him** and He in him. And by this we know that He abides in us, by the Spirit whom He has given us.
- 3. Matt 6:33 But seek first the kingdom of God and His righteousness, and all these things shall be added to you.
- 4. The Wealth Transfer will come to those who abide and bond with God.
  - a. Matt 6:24 No one can serve two masters; for either he will hate the one and love the other, or else he will be loyal to the one and despise the other. You cannot serve God and mammon (riches).
  - b. Prov 13:22 (AMPC) A good man leaves an inheritance [of moral stability and goodness] to his children's children, and the wealth of the sinner [finds its way eventually] into the hands of the (just) righteous, for whom it was laid up.
  - c. Psa 5:12 For You, O Lord, will bless the righteous; with favor You will surround him as with a shield.
  - d. Psa 34:15 The eyes of the Lord are on the righteous, and His ears are open to their cry.
- 5. Matt 6:6 But you, when you pray, go into your room, and when you have shut your door, pray to your Father who is in the secret place; and your Father who sees in secret **will reward you** openly.
- 6. Matt 6:33 (AMPC) But seek (aim at and strive after) first of all His kingdom and His righteousness (His way of doing and being right), and then all these things taken together will be given you besides.
- 7. Some of the Bible Patriarchs who abided and bonded with God:
  - a. Abraham, Isaac, Jacob, Joseph of Egypt, King David, Solomon.
  - b. Solomon's bonding with God resulted in being blessed with Godly wisdom.
  - c. 2 Chronicles 1:11 (AMPC) God replied to Solomon: ...because this was in your heart and you have not asked for riches, possessions, honor, and glory, or the life of your foes, or even for long life, but have asked wisdom and knowledge for yourself, that you may rule and judge My people over whom I have made you king.

#### C. How to Abide and Bond with God.

- 1. Spend quality time with God by setting a daily appointment time with God.
- 2. Get into a prayer mode where you will be uninterrupted with your phone off (home phone and cell phone) and no distractions.
- 3. CRRB, Deal with Unaware Sins, and Re-Establish the KOG frequently. (and if you are HS3 graduate, also 3W).
- 4. Worship with very anointed music for about 15 min to 30 min or more. (Suggest you sing it to the Lord with your hands raised up to Heaven, eyes closed.)



5. Affirm out loud Acts 22:14-15 Affirmation at least 1x:

## Acts 22:14-15 Affirmation:

In the Name of Jesus, according to Acts 22:14-15 (AMPC)
I praise You, Lord that you are the God of my forefathers; and You have destined and appointed me to know Your will [to perceive, to recognize more strongly and clearly, and to become better and more intimately acquainted with Your will], and to see You, the Righteous One (Jesus Christ, my Messiah), and to hear a voice from Your [own] mouth and a message from Your own lips every day continually; and in the Name of Jesus, I am Your witness unto all people of everything that I see and hear that, You, Holy Spirit, teach me.

## **Expanded 1 Cor 2:16 affirmation:**

In the Name of Jesus, according to 1 Cor 2:16, I have the mind of Christ. I can focus perfectly. I have perfect memory and recall. My mind, brain & body function perfectly; and I make perfect decisions because I hear the voice of my God clearly from my Heavenly Father, Jesus my Lord and Savior, and the Holy Spirit my Guide.

- 6. Then speak in Tongues without doing anything else, just being quiet at the feet of Jesus in glad expectation to hear a Word from Jesus, like Martha's sister, Mary did. I call this "Mary" Tongues because "Martha" Tongues is speaking in Tongues while doing other stuff simultaneously. The goal is to speak in Tongues for a minimum of 1 hour.
- 7. Maintain an anointed worship song on low volume while saying your Acts 22:14-15 affirmation to maintain an anointed atmosphere.
- 8. Then stay quiet. Do not worship, sing, pray, affirm or speak in Tongues. Literally do not say anything so your mind and ears (spiritual or physical) will be ready to hear the voice of God.
- 9. Have your Prayer Notebook, or paper, or phone or computer available to write down the communication you receive from the Holy Spirit, Jesus, or the Heavenly Father through a thought, a picture that pops up in your mind, a brief video you see with your mind, a song, a strong sensing in your spirit, or a vision you see with your eyes closed (Closed Vision) or a vision you see with your eyes open (Open Vision is a higher vision).
- 10. Learn to inquire of the Holy Spirit and ask Him about everything you should do in your day beginning from the time you awaken. Include every detail.
- 11. Have that glad expectation of being guided by the Holy Spirit every day all throughout your day. It's very important for us to have that close Unity with the Holy Spirit during these Ending of Days. It will cause you to be more successful and will protect you to a greater degree.



- 12. Acts 2:1-8; 11-21 <sup>1</sup> When the Day of Pentecost had fully come, they were all With one accord in one place. <sup>2</sup> And suddenly there came a sound from heaven, as of a rushing mighty wind, and it filled the whole house where they were sitting. <sup>3</sup> Then there appeared to them divided tongues, as of fire, and one sat upon each of them. 4 And they were all filled with the Holy Spirit and began to speak with other tongues, as the Spirit gave them utterance. <sup>5</sup> And there were dwelling in Jerusalem Jews, devout men, from every nation under heaven. <sup>6</sup> And when this sound occurred, the multitude came together, and were confused, because everyone heard them speak in his own language. <sup>7</sup> Then they were **all amazed and marveled**, saying to one another. <sup>8</sup> And how is it that we hear, each in our own [a]language in which we were born?

  - <sup>11</sup> We hear them speaking in our own tongues the wonderful works of God.
  - <sup>13</sup> Others mocking said, "They are full of new wine."
  - <sup>14</sup> But Peter, standing up with the eleven, raised his voice and said to them, "Men of Judea and all who dwell in Jerusalem, let this be known to you, and heed my words. <sup>15</sup> For these are not drunk, as you suppose, since it is only the third hour of the day. <sup>16</sup> But this is what was spoken by the prophet Joel: <sup>17</sup>'And it shall come to pass in the last days, says God, that I will pour out of My Spirit on all flesh; your sons and your daughters shall prophesy, your young men shall see visions, your old men shall dream dreams. <sup>18</sup> And on my menservants and on my maidservants I will pour out My Spirit in those days; and they shall prophesy. 19 I will show wonders in heaven above and signs in the earth beneath: blood and fire and vapor of smoke. 20 The sun shall be turned into darkness, and the moon into blood, Before the coming of the great and awesome day of the Lord. <sup>21</sup> And it shall come to pass that whoever calls on the name of the Lord shall be saved.
- 13. Jesus abided and bonded with God, the Heavenly Father. Jn 5:19; Mk 1:35; Luke 5:16
  - a. John 5:19 (AMPC) So Jesus answered them by saying, I assure you, most solemnly I tell you, the Son is able to do nothing of Himself (of His own accord); but He is able to do only what He sees the Father doing, for whatever the Father does is what the Son does in the same way [in His turn].
  - b. Mark 1:35 Now in the morning, having risen a long while before daylight, He went out and departed to a solitary place; and there He prayed.
  - c. Luke 5:16 So He Himself often withdrew into the wilderness and prayed
- 14. Each of us should follow the example of Jesus and always abide and bond with God!
